Dear Parents of Juniors and Seniors,

Another school year is about to begin and it is time to start the fundraising for the 2019 Alden-Conger Post Prom Party! Our main fundraiser is providing a meal at each home volleyball and basketball game. Each family of a junior and senior is asked to donate to post prom and this is accomplished by donating \$30 and working at two games this year. **If you cannot work on your assigned date and time, you must find your own replacement.** Names were randomly drawn and assigned to games. A “chairman” has been assigned for each night. The chairman is responsible for contacting the others assigned that game and confirm the menu. If you do not work a shift for any reason you are required to pay \$40.00 (per shift). Please remember that your child is **guaranteed a minimum of \$75 in cash and gas cards for just attending the Post Prom Party** along with hundreds of dollars in other prizes that are given to the attendees! Students do not need to attend prom to attend the post prom party.

At the school each night, there will always be 3 pizza ovens on a cart, large roaster, microwave, extension cord, power bar, napkins, plates, plastic silverware, ketchup, mustard and pickles. **These items will be on a stainless steel table in the hallway outside the gym door** (Mr. Diekman’s classroom). New this year, we have assigned the menu for each night due to food and health regulation requirements. Jamie (school cafeteria) will have the meat warmed for you. If you are serving pizza, you can bring it in already cooked or we have 3 pizza oven which fit Papa Murphy’s Family size pizzas as well as baking the cookies. Also, fresh baked cookies, pretzels, nacho cheese, chips will be available for you to sell. We strongly encourage the sale of nachos, pretzels and cookies each night. Not only do the fans really like them, they offer a very good profit for our group. **The School Board Policy states that we are to arrive at the school at 5:15 pm to set up and start serving. When you are done, please follow the clean up procedure in the 3 ring binder.**

Each month the work schedule will be posted in the school newsletter and available in the main office of the school. We have also posted the information on the Alden-Conger School Website.
