



Voyage Academy Right to Know Policy

Dear Parents,

Voyage Academy Charter School receives Title I and Title II funding and will provide the following to students who qualify as at risk under Title I:

- **Teacher Quality**

We will recruit and hire highly qualified teachers, including those licensed or certified through alternative routes.

Administration has measures in place to retain highly qualified teachers.

The school will support teacher access and acquire necessary professional development and continuing education that leads to licensing and appropriate content preparation.

- **Professional Development**

Teachers will participate in various professional development activities through the school and state during the school year. The professional development activities will include:

Training and mentoring teachers and staff in research based practice.

Providing an onsite mentor for all teacher holding a level 1 license.

All teachers will receive on-site Expeditionary Learning training and occasionally off-site training.

- **Academic and other services**

Voyage will offer Tier II and III services to students who have been identified through Tier I data.

- **Tier II and Tier III support in academics and behavior**

Students who have been identified in need of intense intervention will be referred to the school's RTI program. Students in RTI will be progress monitored on a frequent basis.

A monthly Student Success team meeting will be held to discuss the needs of Tier II and Tier III students.

Parents have the right to know the professional qualifications of their child's classroom teacher.
