1. Notice is hereby given that the governing board ("Board") of the New Haven Unified School District ("District" or "Owner") will receive Prequalification Statements for the following ("Project" or "Contract"):

2. Sealed Confidential Prequalification Statements will be received until **2:00 p.m., Friday February 1, 2019**, at the District Office, 34200 Alvarado Niles Road, Union City, CA 94587, after which time the submitted packets will be reviewed by the District. Any claim by a vendor of error in its packet must be made in compliance with section 5100 et seq. of the Public Contract Code.

3. The Prequalification Statements are to qualify Contractors to bid on future projects in the District.

4. All required information shall be on the forms provided by the District. Each packet must conform and be responsive to all documentation requested by District.

5. To qualify, a Contractor is required to possess a State of California Contractor License.

The Vendor's license(s) must remain active and in good standing throughout the term of the Prequalification.

6. The successful Prequalified Contractors may be required to furnish a 100 % Performance Bond and a 100% Payment Bond if awarded the contract work, based on Contract requirements and value of Project.

7. Contractors may substitute securities for any monies withheld by the District to ensure performance under the Contract, in accordance with the provisions of section 22300 of the Public Contract Code.

8. The Contractor and all Subcontractors under the Contractor shall pay all workers on all work performed pursuant to this Contract not less than the general prevailing rate of per diem wages and the general prevailing rate for holiday and overtime work as determined by the Director of the Department of Industrial Relations, State of California, for the type of work performed and the locality in which the work is to be performed within the boundaries of the District, pursuant to sections 1770 et seq. of the California Labor Code. Prevailing wage rates are also available from the District or on the Internet at: <http://www.dir.ca.gov>. This Project may be funded in whole or in part with State bond funds and, therefore, the District and/or its designee will be operating a labor compliance program on this Project pursuant to Labor Code section 1771.7. The District and/or its designee will be operating a labor compliance program on this Project.
