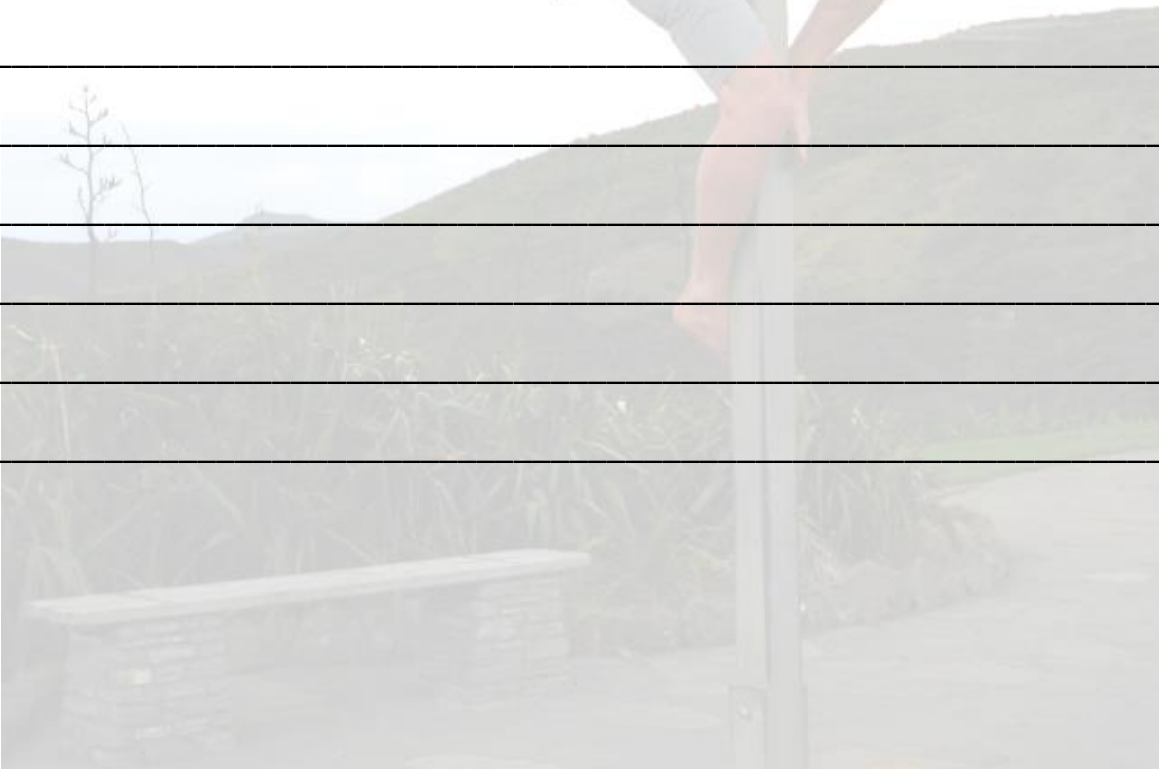

5. What is your favorite board game?



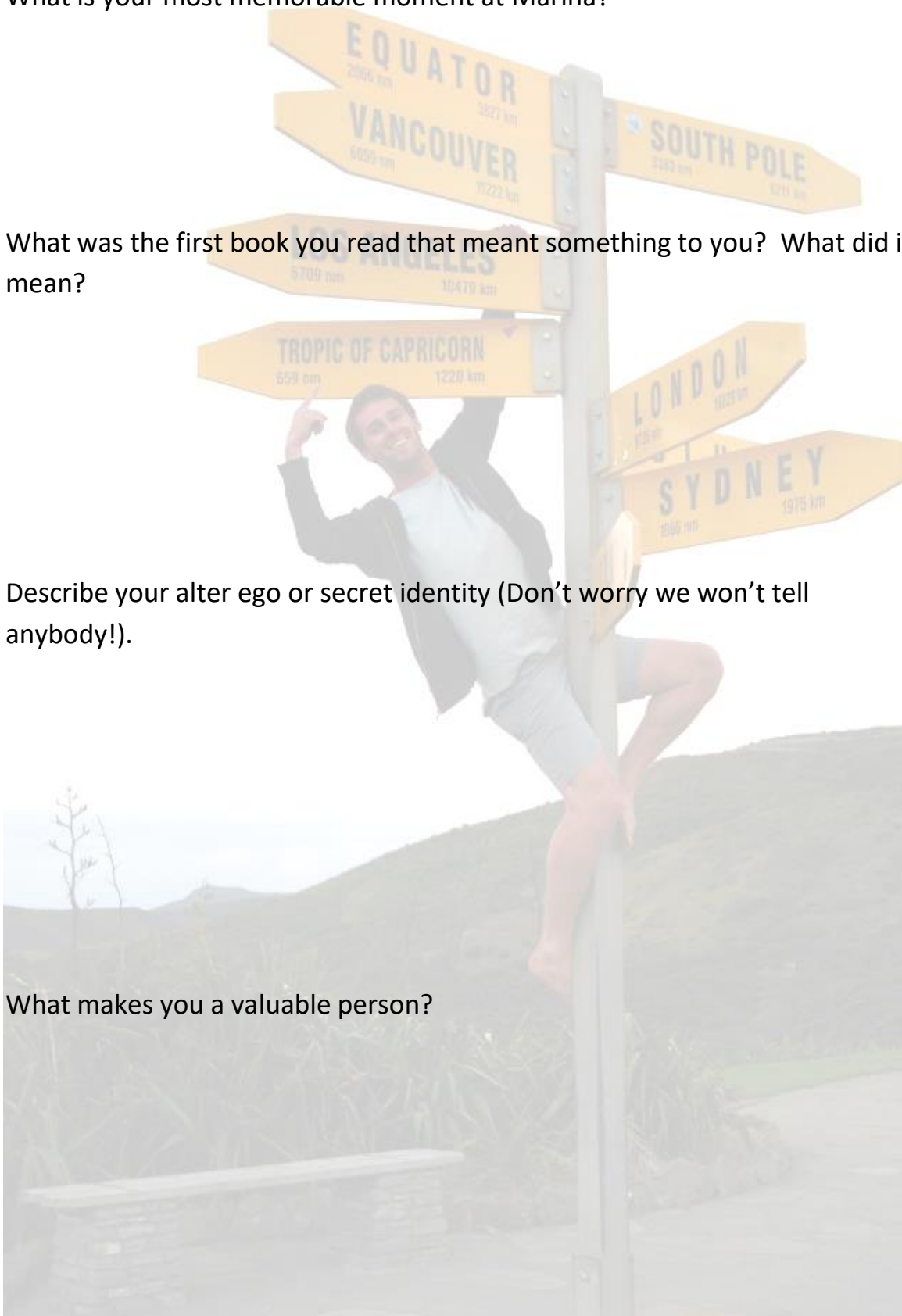
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6. What is your most memorable moment at Marina?
