Household Applications for Free & Reduced Price Meals

Paper applications are available at all schools if you do not want to use the Web based application. One family application either paper or web based will be used to qualify all students in the household even if they attend different schools in the county. Paper applications are scanned then processed. **Please do not use red ink.**

Part 1 each student must be listed with school name, grade, date of birth, indicate if foster or Homeless, Migrant or Runaway

Part 2 list the case number for TANF or SNAP.

DO NOT USE ETB NUMBER.

Part 3 A List student income.

Part 3 B List total household income from last month. It must have the amount of money earned for each wage earner and how often he or she was paid. **Everyone living in the household not in Part 1 must be listed even if they receive no income.** Put total number of household members and last 4 digits of the Social Security Number or check box indicating No SS#

Step 4 Adult signature, date, and additional information. Student applications will be processed faster if parents fill out only one application for the family. Incomplete applications will delay the certification process.
