Self-Directed Survey Preparation

Learn how supports and services will be determined for your son/daughter's future once their school entitlement ends at age 21.

What: For individuals eligible for Division of Developmental Disabilities (DDD) services, this is a forum to clarify the Developmental Disabilities Resource Tool (DDRT). This is the phone survey used by DDD to determine an individual's level of need to provide supports after graduation.

Who should attend: Forum is most appropriate for families who have young adults (14 years of age or older) currently in the transition planning from school to adult-life and professionals working with these families.

Why: An opportunity to better understand the Self-Direction option of DDD Day Services. Examples will be given of individuals and families who are currently self-directing their supports and services. A review of the DDRT will be presented to better prepare you for the phone survey.
