Technique comes from a Greek word meaning "skill." For a dancer, technique is the ability to use physical movements effectively. Movement itself is more elemental than technique for any particular form of dance. The goal of this intensive class is to teach children to move safely and efficiently. The focus is on principles of movement, not on details of style. The students will learn the primary, basic, fundamental uses of the body. By involving the total being, dance can develop the potentials of body, mind, and spirit. To help students find and grow in these potentials is our broad goal for this class.
