## **Kids Unite Mission Statement**

The mission of the Weatherford ISD Kids Unite Program is to promote success for each child in a caring, rewarding, fun and safe environment that will be enriched with opportunities to feel valued and a sense of belonging in the community.

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Dear Parents,

Welcome to Weatherford ISD Kids Unite Summer Camp 2019. Thank you for choosing the Kids Unite Program to provide a safe, fun, nurturing and positive learning environment for your child.

Kids Unite is excited to offer licensed summer child care program for children ages 5-13. This program is available on a weekly basis from June 3 – July 26, 2019. Parents must complete an enrollment form for each child. The registration fee is due upon registering plus the first week. The weekly tuition is due Thursday prior to the week your child(ren) will be participating in Kids Unite. Students should be able to function successfully in a staff to student ratio of 1:22 as well as toilet independently.

Our Kids Unite staff members are American Red Cross CPR/First Aid certified and selected for their maturity, patience, experience and ability to work with children. All staff members have criminal background clearance from WISD and the Department of Family Protective Services.

All admission forms must be completed before your child may participate in the WISD Kids Unite Summer Camp Program.

## Program Components

### Hours of Operation:

- Kids Unite summer program hours are 7:00 a.m. - 6:30 p.m. Monday thru Friday, from June 3 - July 26, 2019. Holiday on July 4<sup>th</sup> 2019.

### Tuition Payments:

- Tuition paid weekly and is due on Thursday prior to the week that your child will be attending the program.
- **Tuition:** \$145 per week (includes breakfast, lunch and afternoon snack, field trips, swimming and a camp t-shirt). \*\*July 2-5 tuition is \$130; no camp on July 4, 2019.  
**Registration fee:** \$30 per family. Valid from First Day of School - 2019 through End of Summer-2020.
- Refunds will only be issued as credit vouchers to be used for summer camp or the after school program.

### Child Care Standards:

- The playgrounds do not meet licensing requirements, but will still be used as it is located on the public school grounds.

### Medical Information:

- Kids Unite does not maintain a school nurse or other health professional on staff. At times during the summer a nurse within the school district may be available. We will call 911 for any serious medical emergencies that may occur.
- If your child does require medication, a Kids Unite Supervisor member will administer the medication as directed by the student's physician and current "Medication Form" form available from the Site Director and on our website. Please indicate all of your child's health needs on the enrollment form (i.e. –allergies requiring Epi-pen administration, asthma inhalers.) We will keep these medications locked up when not in use.
- For students with life-threatening allergies/conditions including food allergies: an asthma/allergy action plan form must be submitted to the Kids Unite Supervisor. The form must be from the physician's office.

- If your child becomes ill during Kids Unite hours, we will contact you immediately. A parent or someone on your child's authorized pick-up list should come to pick-up the child within an hour upon request.
- By state regulation, you must keep your child home until your child is free from all symptoms of illness listed below:
  - (1) The illness prevents the child from participating comfortably in the operation activities including outdoor play.
  - (2) The illness results in a greater need for care than caregivers can provide without compromising the health, safety, and supervision of the other children in care.
  - (3) The child has one of the following (unless a medical evaluation by a health-care professional indicates that you can include the child in your operation's activities):
    - (A) An oral temperature above 101 degrees that is accompanied by behavior changes or other signs or symptoms of illness.
    - (B) A tympanic (ear) temperature above 100 degrees that is accompanied by behavior changes or other signs or symptoms of illness.
    - (C) An axillary (armpit) temperature above 100 degrees that is accompanied by behavior changes or other signs or symptoms of illness. Or
    - (D) Symptoms and signs of possible severe illness such as lethargy, abnormal breathing, uncontrolled diarrhea, two or more vomiting episodes in 24 hours, rash with fever, mouth sores with drooling, behavior changes, or other signs that the child may be severely ill.
  - Or (4) A health-care professional has diagnosed the child with a communicable disease, and the child does not have medical documentation to indicate that the child is no longer contagious.
- All immunization records and health statements are kept on file at the child's home campus. If your child does not attend the Weatherford ISD Schools then you will be required to provide immunization records and health statement.
- Kids Unite would prefer that parent/guardian apply sunscreen prior to attendance each morning at home. However, with your permission we will provide sunscreen as needed. We will use the Rocky Mountain SPF 30 brand. It will be applied before the activity outside and repeated during the day if needed to the exposed skin by the caregiver on duty.
- Kids Unite will not apply Insect Repellant to a child. This should be done at home if desired by the parent.

**Drop Off/Pick Up Information:**

- **Please enter the back door of Ikard Elementary. Doors will be locked. You will need to call for admission if the door is unmanned. Kids Unite cell phone number will be posted on the door.**
- All parents and other authorized pick up persons will have to show a photo ID to the Kids Unite Staff before your child will be released until recognition is achieved. This is for the safety of your child. Please make sure you bring your ID in with you each day in case our regular staff is not present.

- No one under the age of 18 may pick-up a child unless they are a sibling. Their names must be on the pick-up list and authorized in writing by the parent or guardian.
- All persons picking up the student must sign them out each day on the Kids Unite Sign In/Out Sheet. You will need to initial and enter the time of pick-up.
- We may request an earlier arrival on field trip days. You are welcome to pick up your child(ren) at any time prior to 6:30 p.m.
- Your child should be picked up by 6:30 p.m. A \$1.00 per minute late fee will be assessed for each child. The school's clock will be used as the official timepiece. If emergencies occur, please notify the Kids Unite Supervisor at 817-598-2806, .ext. 3235 before 6:30 p.m. Calling ahead will not absolve you of any late charges, but will curtail the anxiety your child feels when no one has arrived by 6:30 p.m. If children are repeatedly picked up late, they are subject to removal from the program. Please designate a friend/neighbor who can pick up your child if an emergency prevents you from arriving on time.

**Absent Student:**

- If your child is unable to attend Kids Unite due to illness or other activity, please call the Kids Unite phone at 817-598-2806, ext. 3235 and leave a message for the Supervisor or communicate in person the day before absence.

**Enrichment Camps:**

- A Kids Unite student may leave the summer camp program to participate in one of the Enrichment Camps located at the same campus if they have been registered to participate. Please inform the Site Director/Supervisor that your child will be attending this other activity. Our KU Staff will walk your child to and from their camp. Please see the Community Education webpage, <https://comed.weatherfordisd.com> to view and register for the available Enrichment Camps.

**Discipline:**

We expect to have few discipline problems with the Kids Unite children because we will be keeping them engaged in learning and fun. However, if misbehavior does occur, please know that our staff will try redirecting their behavior before your child will be placed in time-out.

- If a student continues to misbehave after a time-out, the parent will receive a "Discipline Action Form." An example is included later in this handbook.
- A student who has continual problems managing their behavior may occur a suspension from attending Kids Unite or be expelled from the program depending on the circumstances.
- Kids Unite has a zero-tolerance for bullying and/or physical aggression toward others.
- No group consequences for misbehavior will be given.
- Kids Unite is a gang-free zone. No student generated "clubs" will be allowed.
- Our staff will be using a "Love and Logic" approach to discipline with all students. Consequences will be logical for poor student choices. For example, if a child is making bad choices in the computer lab, they will have a time-out from computers.
- Please note the official Discipline Guidance Policy below.

- All cell phones, electronic game devices and toys should be left at home or in your child's backpack during Kids Unite. Kids Unite is not responsible or liable for the theft, loss or breakage of any item of this type.

## **Discipline and Guidance Policy for Kids Unite Summer Camp**

➤ Discipline must be:

- (1) Must be consistent with the program's policies and procedures;
- (2) Not be physically or emotionally damaging to the child;
- (3) Appropriate to the child's age and level of understanding; and
- (4) Appropriate to the incident and severity of the behavior demonstrated.

➤ A caregiver may only use positive methods of discipline and guidance that encourages self-esteem, self-control, and self-direction, including the following:

- (1) Using praise and encouragement of good behavior instead of focusing only upon unacceptable behavior,
- (2) Reminding a child of behavior expectations daily by using clear, positive statements,
- (3) Redirecting behavior using positive statements; and
- (4) Using brief supervised separation or time out from the group, when appropriate for the child's age and development, which is limited to no more than one minute per year of the child's age.

➤ There must be no harsh, cruel, or unusual treatment of any child. The following types of discipline and guidance are prohibited:

- (1) Corporal punishment or threats of corporal punishment;
- (2) Punishment associated with food, naps, or toilet training;
- (3) Pinching, shaking, or biting a child;
- (4) Hitting a child with a hand or instrument;
- (5) Putting anything in or on a child's mouth;
- (6) Humiliating, ridiculing, rejecting, or yelling at a child;
- (7) Subjecting a child to harsh, abusive, or profane language;
- (8) Placing a child in a locked or dark room, bathroom, or closet; and
- (9) Requiring a child to remain silent or inactive for inappropriately long periods of time for the child's age.

**Safety and Security:**

- The children in Kids Unite will be supervised at all times by a member of the Kids Unite staff. We will be using a roster system to check attendance at various times throughout the day. The outside doors into the school will remain locked throughout the day. You will need to call the Kids Unite Supervisor/Site Director in order to be admitted into the building. Kids Unite Cell Phone Number will be posted on the door.
- All Kids Unite staff members have cleared a criminal background check required for all WISD and DFPS employees.
- Staff are not required to have vaccines against croup or TB, but we strongly recommend they get the flu shot.
- In case an emergency evacuation is necessary, our Off Site Evacuation Site is The Texas Pythian Home, 1835 East Bankhead Dr., Weatherford, TX 76086 Our Alternate Evacuation Site is Kangaroo Stadium 1007 S. Main St., Weatherford, TX 76086. The Emergency Plan is located in the Postings Binder, as well as in each staff member's binder.

**Food:**

- Kids Unite Summer Camp students will be provided breakfast, lunch and an afternoon snack.
- You are welcome to provide breakfast and/or lunch for your child only.
- Water will be available at all times.
- If your child has any food allergies, there will need to be a food allergy emergency plan provided by your doctor on file on-site. Parents may provide breakfast and/or lunch for their child only.

**Field Trips:**

- Kids Unite will have a field trip every week. Students must wear their Kids Unite t-shirts on the field trips. Staff will increase to a 1:10 ratio. We will use a Weatherford ISD bus for our trip transportation as well as one of their certified bus drivers.
- Swimming will be at the Texas Pythian Home. Children will need to test their swimming ability with one of the certified lifeguards on staff before they will be allowed to swim in the deep end. There will be KU staff in the water and others patrolling from the side of the pool in addition to a certified lifeguard on duty. Staff ratio will increase to a 1:10 ratio. The lifeguard is not included in this ratio.
- We have posted the field trip schedule on the website and hard copies will be available in the pick-up area.
- Parent permission is required for the children to participate in all field trips, plus swimming activities. You will sign your permission on the registration form when you enroll your child.
- Parents are welcome to visit the program at any time, but you must visit with your child in the presence of one or more of our Kids Unite staff. We would love to have you come see the fun activities your child participates in each day. Parents may also participate in the field trips, but you must provide your own transportation. You will be required to fill out a WISD Volunteer Application in advance. Please check in with the Kids Unite Supervisor on duty and let them know when you wish to visit or participate. Your child must ride the bus on the field trip. You may sign-out your child at the end of the field trip and they can ride home with you.

Fulfilled expectations by all parties involved in the Kids Unite program will mean a successful venture for all!

### **Parents may expect that:**

- Their children are cared for in a supportive and consistent environment.
- They may visit with the Site Director/Kids Unite Supervisor about concerns related to their child or the program.
- They will be told about any issues of concern about their child and have the opportunity to visit with the Site Director in order to bring about improvement in the situation.
- They will be called if their child becomes ill or is injured during Kids Unite.
- Mutual respect towards parents and children will be promoted by the Kids Unite staff.

### **Children may expect:**

- To have a supportive, positive and consistent environment.
- To use all Kids Unite equipment, materials and facilities on an equal basis.
- To receive respectful treatment.
- To have fair and logical discipline.
- To receive nurturing care from Kids Unite Staff Members.

### **Kids Unite expects that children will:**

- Display responsible conduct.
- Exhibit an attitude of respect toward others.
- Respect and obey the program rules and staff.
- Remain with their group and the Kids Unite staff at all times.
- Take care of materials and equipment properly.
- Leave cell phone and toys at home or in their backpacks.

### **Kids Unite expects that parents will:**

- Pay tuition and fees in a timely manner.
- Pick up their child on time.
- Call the Kids Unite Supervisor if they will be running late to pick-up their child.
- Contact the Kids Unite Supervisor by calling Kids Unite office at 817-598-2806 to leave a message if their child will not be attending on a scheduled day.
