## School Highlights Reported by the District

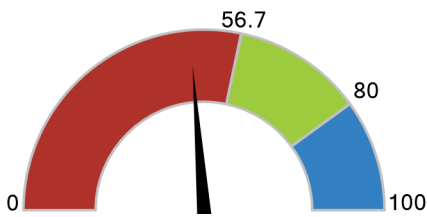
- Carteret High School completed the Middle States Accreditation Process led by teacher leaders.

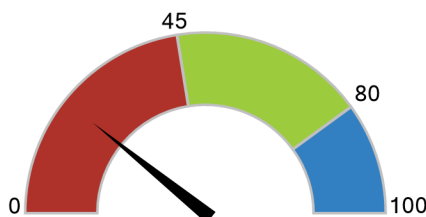

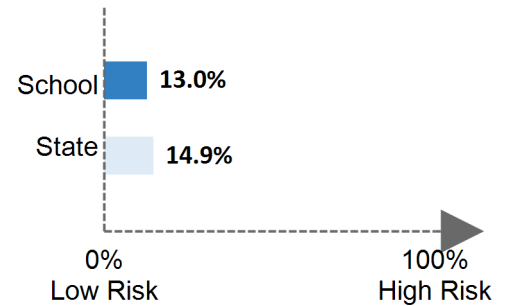

Students that were absent for 10% or more of days enrolled

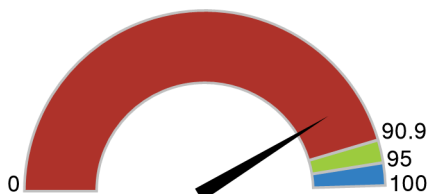
#### Chronic Absenteeism
