GRADUATION ANNOUNCEMENTS

PLACE: ASB OFFICE

Those who have already ordered their announcements from Jostens may pick them up in the ASB Office. Office hours are before school, at brunch, or at lunch. Late orders must be placed directly with Jostens at (818) 367-2929.

YEARBOOKS

If you have not purchased a yearbook, the last day to order books from the ASB Office is May 10 for \$100 while supplies last. Starting May 13, yearbooks can be purchased in C-1 for \$100, while supplies last. Yearbooks will be distributed to seniors starting Friday, May 17, from C-1 at lunch. Starting May 20, yearbooks will be distributed to all grade levels during brunch, lunch, and after school in room C-1. There will not be distribution during any class time. Students must have \$100 cash or check (made out to Hart ASB) with them in order to buy a book.

CLEARANCE / DELINQUENCIES

All books and materials are to be turned in before the final exam period for each class (unless needed for the exam itself). Beginning May 28, only cash will be accepted in the library.

All financial delinquencies are to be paid in full before graduation. Pay textbook/library delinquencies/fines in the Library. All other delinquencies are to be paid in the ASB Office.
