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SERVICE LEARNING VERIFICATION FORM

As a graduation requirement at Garden Spot High School, students beginning with the class of 2016 are required to fulfill at least 30 hours of service learning **outside the regular school day**. The hours are required to be completed prior to senior year. Paperwork should be turned in upon completion of each activity. All paperwork is due to the high school guidance office in September of senior year.

The service learning must directly benefit the community and/or its members. **Unpaid services which benefit or assist family members or a local business do not count as service learning. Examples: babysitting, internship, apprenticeship. Fees may not be exchanged.** If there is a question as to what constitutes "service learning hours," approval will be determined by the principal of the high school.

This form is to be turned in to the high school guidance department after completion of hours at any particular organization that fits within the parameters as described above. Please print legibly.
