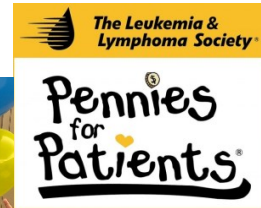
Competition and was chosen as the Teacher of the Year from 25 posts! Congratulations Mrs. Leatherman! We are very proud of you!
