REGIONAL OCCUPATIONAL PROGRAM

The Board of Education, in order to broaden the vocational educational experiences for students in the San Lorenzo Unified School District, is a participating district with the San Leandro Unified School District, the Castro Valley Unified School District and Hayward Unified School District in a joint venture. The program is administrated by the Eden Area Regional Occupational Program, an entity created by a joint powers agreement between the four participating districts.

The Board directs one of its members to represent the Board on the Eden Area Regional Occupational Program Governing Council to act in its behalf and provide the necessary liaison for the administration of the Regional Occupational Program and Center.

REGIONAL OCCUPATIONAL PROGRAM

Student Excused From Physical Education For Travel Hardship

Any pupil enrolled in grade 10, 11, or 12, and who is attending a regional occupational center or regional occupational program may be excused from attending courses in Physical Education by the Governing Board of the school district maintaining grade 10, 11, or 12, and in which the pupil is enrolled, if attendance upon such classes results in hardship because of travel time involved.

If a pupil is excused from Physical Education classes pursuant to this section, the minimum school day for him in his regular high school is 180 minutes.
