## WESTERN YOUTH SERVICES AT CLARA J. KING ELEMENTARY

Dear Parent/Guardian,

Clara J. King Elementary partners with Western Youth Services (WYS) to provide a variety of mental health services as well as a full-time WYS provider (Behavioral Health Aide) on campus. The goal of these services is to increase awareness, build resilience, cultivate success, and promote positive self-esteem.

The Behavioral Health Aide (BHA), Mark Gazmen, will be hosting a “Lunch Club” on campus, during lunchtime hours. The purpose of the Lunch Club is to provide a safe environment where kids can come to participate in fun, skill-building activities. The club will focus on developing skills to address conflict, develop and maintain friendships, and build leadership skills. The Lunch Club will be available on Tuesdays and Thursdays for grades 1<sup>st</sup>-6<sup>th</sup>. **Student participation in lunch club is voluntary.**

In addition, the Behavioral Health Aide provides classroom workshops, recess/lunch support, small group, and individualized interventions/support. When necessary this may include gathering information when a safety concern for self or others arises. Under such circumstances every attempt will be made to reach you using your child’s emergency card information. Furthermore, pertinent information may be shared with school and/or district staff to ensure your child’s safety needs are met.
