DRESS POLICY FOR DANCES & PROMS

Below is our Dress Policy for our Dances & Proms. Please read this policy carefully and make sure you follow it when selecting an outfit to attend our dances and proms. Thank you!

Dress Policy for Dances & Proms

With modesty in mind, the following dress code guidelines will be enforced at the Freshman/Sophomore Dance and at the Senior and Junior Proms. Students must dress in a manner appropriate for these Catholic school dances and proms, a manner that reflects our Catholic values.

The dress policy for the Freshman/Sophomore Dance is as follows:

- ❖ Skirts/dresses are to be mid-thigh or lower.
- ❖ Midriffs may not be exposed.
- ❖ No plunging necklines.

The dress policy for Proms is as follows:

- ❖ Strapless or halter gowns are permitted. However, dresses with plunging necklines or that reveal too much bustline are unacceptable.
- ❖ Dresses may be backless as long as they are not below the navel.
- ❖ Midriffs may not be exposed. This includes both front and sides. Mesh covered cutouts are not permitted.
- ❖ Slits are to be no higher than “finger-tip” length.

You will not be permitted to enter the dance/prom if you are not dressed appropriately.
