Prom tickets can be purchased with cash or credit card or through our on-line store. However, only individual tickets will be on sale through the on-line store. If your student is bringing a non-West Ranch guest, they will need to purchase their tickets in the ASB Office. Also, they need to make sure they bring their **signed** contracts, guest contract is on ASB website, along with a copy of their Guest's PHOTO ID when purchasing their tickets.

NO CONTRACT, MISSING SIGNATURES AND NO PHOTO ID, NO TICKET SALE!

Guests are welcome as long as they attend with a West Ranch Student and have been approved by the administration; Photo ID required along with agreement and on night of Prom.

All Guests must be between the ages of 14-20 and may not be a student at a junior high school.

Refund requests need to be made by April 17th, no refunds will be given after this date. Students wishing to change their date will be assessed a \$20 fee and cash will only be accepted. Changes can be made up to April 19th.

Students with delinquencies and balance dues must clear them prior to purchasing a prom ticket.

TIMELINE OF THE EVENING

- 4:30** STUDENTS ARE TO REPORT TO THE LARGE GYM TO REGISTER. AT THAT TIME THEY WILL **CHECK-IN AND RECEIVE THEIR BUS TICKETS.** AFTER STUDENTS HAVE CHECKED IN, THEY WILL REMAIN IN LARGE GYM. SNACKS AND DRINKS WILL BE PROVIDED BY THE WEST RANCH PAC.
- 5:15** ALL STUDENTS MUST BE IN THE LARGE GYM BY 5:15 PM. STUDENTS WILL START TO LINE-UP FOR THE PROMENADE AND BUS LOADING.
- 5:30** PROMENADE STARTS: STUDENTS ARE ESCORTED THROUGH THE PROMENADE WITH THEIR CHAPERONES. THE PROMENADE WILL BE HELD IN THE OUTDOOR AMPHITHEATER. **PARENTS AND FRIENDS ARE INVITED TO ATTEND THE PROMENADE.**
- 6:30** BUSES LEAVE WEST RANCH
- 7:30** BUSES ARRIVE AT PETERSEN AUTOMOTIVE MUSEUM
- 10:30** CORONATION OF THE 2019 PROM KING AND QUEEN
- 11:30** PROM ENDS, DEPART FROM MUESUM TO WEST RANCH

PROMENADE

ON THE EVENING OF PROM, PLEASE ARRIVE AT WEST RANCH NO LATER THAN 5:15 PM AND REPORT DIRECTLY TO THE WEST RANCH LARGE GYM TO CHECK-IN. THE PROMENADE IS SCHEDULED TO BEGIN AT 5:30 PM, SO PLEASE BE PROMPT! PARENTS AND FRIENDS ARE INVITED TO ATTEND THE PROMENADE IN THE OUTDOOR AMPHITHEATER.

TRANSPORTATION

ALL STUDENTS MUST TAKE A BUS TO PROM. THOUGH EVERY EFFORT IS MADE FOR STUDENTS TO RIDE A CHARTER BUS, IT IS NOT GUARANTEED. SOME STUDENTS MAY HAVE TO RIDE SCHOOL BUSES.

COAT CHECK

A COAT CHECK WILL BE AVAILABLE AT THE MUSEUM. SHOES AND PURSES WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO BE CHECKED IN.

CORONATION

OUR COURT CORONATION WILL BEGIN AT 10:45 PM ON THE MAIN DANCE FLOOR. START GATHERING EARLY SO THAT YOU'LL BE SURE TO SEE OUR PROM KING AND QUEEN CROWNED.

ENDING THE EVENING

AS THE EVENING WINDS DOWN, BUSES WILL BEGIN TO LEAVE THE PROM AT THE CONCLUSION OF CORONATION. IF YOU WOULD LIKE TO BE ON ONE OF THE FIRST BUSES, SIMPLY ASSEMBLE AT THE ENTRANCE TO THE MUSEUM. ADMINISTRATORS WILL ASSIST YOU IN BOARDING. EACH BUS WILL NOT LEAVE UNTIL IT IS FULL. THE LAST SONG WILL FINISH AT 11:30PM.

PROM CHECK LIST

STEP 1:

Go to the Library during brunch & lunch and get your Library Clearance stamp. Before going to the library, make sure you fill out the student information on the Prom Agreement. BE SURE TO BRING ID CARD.

STEP 2:

Pay all miscellaneous school fines. Pay for all outstanding parking tickets or other outstanding fines at the ASB Office. You may also pay fines at www.westtranchhighschool.com ; click on web store, sign in and any outstanding debts are cleared through "unpaid items" icon.

STEP 3:

Pay for your prom ticket. Students can pay for their prom tickets at the ASB Office or at our on line web store. Tickets can be purchased in the ASB Office during brunch and lunch only. Make sure you have cleared all fines and bring your completed Prom Agreement Form and school ID. If you purchase on line, please bring your completed Prom Agreement Form into the ASB office the following day. Payments accepted are cash and credit/debit card ONLY.

CONTROLLED SUBSTANCE POLICY

In particular, your attention is called to the Wm. S. Hart Union High School District's policy on possession/use/influence of alcohol, drugs or any controlled substances (AR 5131.6). Stated simply:

Any student who has unlawfully possessed, used, sold or otherwise furnished or been under the influence of any controlled substance as defined in Section 11032 of the Health and Safety Code, alcoholic beverage or intoxicant of any kind at school or any school sponsored activity shall be subject to:

1. An immediate five (5) day out-of-school suspension;
2. Possible arrest by law enforcement authorities;
3. Possible expulsion from all schools in the District;
4. Possible transfer to another school or educational program;
5. Possible denial of the privilege of participation in graduation ceremonies and/or extracurricular activities.

School personnel will check all students prior to entering the event, and security officers will monitor activity throughout the evening. You are further advised that any such violation of the above policy will necessitate your parents providing transportation home from the event and your ticket will not be refunded.

GUESTS

West Ranch High School may opt to allow non-West Ranch students to attend dances as guests. West Ranch students must have their guest approved by filling out their own contract. West Ranch High School administrators will screen the list of all guests. If your guest is not eligible to attend you will be asked to choose another. Please note: All guests must be between the ages of 14 and 20 and may not be a student at a junior high school. Guests need to provide photo identification when purchasing the ticket and at the door. If the guest is over 18, they still must obtain a parent/guardian signature. If you cannot obtain a parent/guardian signature, this line must be signed by a West Ranch administrator.

DRESS CODE

The school dress code will be enforced at all dances, please review prior to attending. Students must remain dressed throughout the dance in the same manner as they entered. **IF YOU ARE DRESSED INAPPROPRIATELY, YOU WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO ENTER THE DANCE AND YOUR MONEY WILL NOT BE REFUNDED.** West Ranch administration retains the authority to ban specific clothing to maintain event safety. If you have questions regarding dance attire, please contact the ASB Office.

DANCE CONDUCT

Students and their guests are expected to behave appropriately on the dance floor. Any students or guests who engage in dangerous, lewd or other inappropriate behavior on the dance floor, including any dancing that may be interpreted as being sexually suggestive, will be removed from the dance and sent home without a refund.

VOLUNTARY ACTIVITIES PARTICIPATION – ACKNOWLEDGEMENT & ASSUMPTION OF POTENTIAL RISK

I understand and acknowledge that participation in these activities, by their very nature, pose the potential risk of serious injury/illness to individuals who participate in such activities. I understand and acknowledge that participation in these activities is completely voluntary and as such is not required by the District for course credit or for completion of graduation requirements. I understand and acknowledge that in order to participate in these activities, my son/daughter and I agree to assume liability and responsibility for any and all potential risks that may be associated with participation in such activities. I understand, acknowledge, and agree that the District, its employees, officers, agents, or volunteers shall not be liable for any injury/illness suffered by my son/daughter which is incident to and/or associated with preparing for and/or participating in these activities.

AUTHORIZATION FOR MEDICAL CARE

Should it be necessary for my son/daughter to have medical care, I hereby give the school district personnel permission to use their judgment in obtaining medical care and ambulance service.
