**AT&T** - offers **low-cost wireline home Internet service** to qualifying households:

- With at least one resident who participates in the U.S. Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) and
- With an address in AT&T's 21-state service area, at which we offer wireline home Internet service, and
- Without outstanding debt for AT&T fixed Internet service within the last six months or outstanding debt incurred under this program.

**Xfinity** offers an **Internet Essentials** program that allows qualifying customers to purchase a plan for just \$9.95 per month. **Internet Essentials** is designed to help students, seniors, and **low-income families**. The program offers 15 Mbps **internet** and free in-home Wi-Fi and requires no credit check.

**Everyoneon.org** is a national nonprofit working to eliminate the digital divide by making high-speed, low-cost Internet service and computers, and free digital literacy courses accessible to all unconnected Americans. We aim to leverage the democratizing power of the Internet to provide opportunity to all Americans – regardless of age, race, geography, income, or education level. Bringing Affordable Internet & Devices Into the Home Through partnerships with local Internet service providers, EveryoneOn is able to low-income households usually between \$10 - \$20 per month.
