

FISD Parents,

In order to meet the instructional needs of our students, FISD is implementing a system that allows parents to access their student's curriculum during the time our students will be at home.

The primary method would be to access your student's work online through links provided on our FISD district website. A link to the *Student Learning and Instruction from Home* website (www.farmersvilleisd.org), which will be posted at noon this Friday, will allow students to access assignments from individual teachers through campus links.

Students who do not have online access in their homes will be able to pick up instructional packets with equivalent assignments to those online at their home campus.

The difference in content between the two options is that the online assignments may have more interaction through media and video to help facilitate your student's learning. We do feel confident in your student having full access to the required content if they have to access their curriculum through picking up instructional packets at their home campus.

Starting Friday, March 20th, if you will be accessing your student's assignment through campus pickup, we will be doing that from the hours of 8am – 4pm on Fridays. We will be distributing your student's packet in a similar fashion to that of car pickup on our elementary campuses. Parents will not be required to come inside any campus. We will have a late pickup on Mondays, beginning March 23rd, from 5p – 7p. To facilitate the process, would you please place a large card in your car window with your student's name clearly displayed with grade level.

If your student requires tutorials, each campus will be establishing times for small group tutorial sessions throughout the week, and that information will also be posted on the FISD website.
