## Bring Your Own Device (BYOD) at Ridgecrest!

Ridgecrest Intermediate School believes it is increasingly important for students to have the ability to utilize technology as a tool to access information, research topics of interest, and to apply the technology skills in daily work at school and at home. Student-owned devices provide students with the opportunity to have ownership of the technology needed to compete in and complete work in the 21st century and provide more consistent and frequent access to this tool. Every college and career path requires students to utilize technology both in the classroom and in preparation for the work setting. RIS Staff has made a commitment to making the district's Bring Your Own Device (BYOD) Policy into an active part of our instructional program.

It is our desire to have students interact more regularly with laptops and electronic devices during the academic day as a part of our instructional program. While this has been done with various labs and Chromebooks at RIS, we would like to encourage students to all bring a device to make this a more consistent and dependable practice. Much of our new instructional materials and programs have internet-based features which would benefit our students with supported daily access from our staff.

**Requirements:** All students must return the Terms & Agreement signature form signed by the students and parent/guardian to the school office before use of electronic information services in the classroom, computer lab or library media center. Terms & Agreement Form: <https://goo.gl/qkfjhh>

**Use of Personal Technology Devices & BYOD (Bring Your Own Device):** In accordance with Board Policy 5131, students may use personal technology devices but must follow all guidelines of this policy and all campus and classroom rules. The PVPUSD is not responsible for the loss, theft or damage to any personal technology device. Access to and usage of District and campus networks with a personal device is in accordance with all District policies, rules, and guidelines outlined in this Acceptable Use Policy. The use of personal devices by students is optional. A backpack with a "padded" option is allowed in all classes all day. Students will be expected to comply with all class and school rules while using personal devices. ## General School Supply List

These are the general items recommended for all students.

- 2-inch D-ring general binder for use in all academic classes
- 8 dividers
- 1 Quad-ruled composition book (7 ½ " X 9 ¾ ") for Science class
- 1 notebook of graph paper for Math class
- 3 highlighters of different colors (yellow, pink, green, etc.)
- 2 red ballpoint pens
- 2 black or blue ballpoint pens
- 3 #2 Pencils
- 1 Rubber eraser
- 3 Glue sticks
- 1 Pack of loose leaf lined paper (100 sheets) \*not in a spiral
- 1 Box of assorted colored pencils (12 colors)
- 300 index cards (3"x5")
- 1 12" Ruler - showing centimeters and inches
- 3 fine-point markers of different colors (red, blue, black, etc.)
