

# Instrumental Music Supply List

Mrs. Terranova, Instrumental Music Teacher

Regardless of specific class, it is recommended that **ALL** students bring the supplies listed below:

1. Pencils (no pens)
2. A 2-pocket folder **or** 1/2"-1" binder for sheet music (*sheet protectors for binders are recommended!*)
3. A few sheets of blank staff paper (printed here: <http://www.blanksheetmusic.net/>)

## **Beginning Band & Beginning Orchestra**

Students will be given instrument-specific cleaning/maintenance supplies (cork grease, valve oil, rosin, etc.) based on their chosen instrument assignment, to be determined within the first 2 weeks of instruction.

*\*Note: Please don't buy an instrument for this class. Students are advised to rent for the first year.*

## **Advanced Band & Advanced Orchestra**

Students need to bring their instrument-specific cleaning/maintenance supplies (cork grease, valve oil, etc.) that apply to their instrument.

*\*Note: Students should already know their supplies from previous year's class, but here is a general list according to instrument family:*

Brass	Woodwind	Percussion
Valve oil, slide grease, mouthpiece brush, cleaning snake, small 3oz spray bottle ( <i>for trombone only</i> ), cleaning cloth	Cork grease ( <i>flute &amp; clar. only</i> ), size 2 or 2½ reeds ( <i>clar. &amp; sax only</i> ), cleaning swab for inside, cleaning rod ( <i>flute only</i> ), cleaning cloth for outside	Snare drum sticks (5B or SD1)
