## 2018 Kindergarten Orientation

**Wednesday, August 29<sup>th</sup> at 9:30AM**

This is a required informational meeting that will help ensure your child has a smooth transition to kindergarten. This required informational meeting last approximately 2 hours.

During the meeting you will meet your child's teacher and gain an understanding of what is expected in kindergarten. You'll get to experience a bit of your child's daily routine including a short bus ride and visit to the cafeteria. (*Younger siblings or other children will not be permitted on the bus.*)

You will also be able to confirm your child's bus pick-up & drop-off times, bus stop locations, and bus assignments.

### Important Information for Bus Riders

- Perry Local School District is not required to transport students attending schools outside their assigned communities through open enrollment; transportation is the responsibility of the parent.
- A bus is not required to wait for a late student. Riders should be ready to board the bus at their assigned stop - five minutes before the scheduled pick-up time.
- Drivers are required to drop off a child only at assigned stop. For a child to be picked up or dropped off at a different stop a transportation change request must be approved by the Transportation Supervisor, Randy Paxton.
