With your help, our 9th Annual Walk for Kids will be a huge success! Volunteer support is what makes this event possible! Listed below are the areas that we need assistance with, along with a brief description of what the job entails. All information will be confirmed prior to the event.

Saturday, April 25th:

Prep and Load – Time: 11:30am-12:30pm. Meet at LBRMH to gather supplies and load truck. This job will require lifting of some heavy items.

Sunday, April 26th:

Event Set Up Crew – Time: 5:00-8:00am, or until set up is complete. Assist with unloading and placement of items including supplies, booths, tables, signs, banners, and set up of areas such as: Registration, Food, Kids Zone, VIP Tent, and Walkers Village.

Food Tent –Time: 6:00-10:30am, or event conclusion. Set up food and snack area and man the booth during the Walk. When the Walk winds down, help will be needed in breaking down the Food Tent and gathering any items that will be placed back on the truck to be returned to the LBRMH.

Volunteer Check In –Time: 5:30am until event conclusion. Several shifts will be scheduled during this timeframe. Check in volunteers, have them sign in and complete waiver form. Re-assign volunteers as needed to provide help throughout the event.

Walker Registration –Time: 5:30-8:30am. Set up registration area. Check in walkers, collecting any necessary paperwork, registration fees and fundraising dollars. Registration goes rather quickly, but is very fast paced. You will need to be comfortable in dealing with lines of participants needing to register or drop off funds and collect prizes.

Incentive Prize Distribution – Time: 5:30-8:30am. Incentive Prize Volunteers will pull incentive merchandise as need by the registration volunteers, based on requested size, etc. Registration goes rather quickly, but is very fast paced. You will need to be comfortable in dealing with lines of participants needing to register or drop off funds and collect prizes.

Kids Zone – Time: 6:30-10:30am. A fun interactive area, the Kids Zone will have games, crafts and other activities. We are looking for volunteers in small groups of 2-4 to manage an Activity or Craft Table in the Kids Zone. At the conclusion of the event, help will be needed in breaking down the Kids Zone and gathering any items that will be placed back on the truck to be returned to the LBRMH.

Walk Route Crew and Cheerleaders – Great for Groups! Time: 7:00 am-9:30am. These volunteers will be placed all throughout the Walk Course, providing direction to walkers, keeping the walk route clean, and cheering on walkers. Cheerleading squads and large groups would be perfect for this job!

Event Break Down and Clean Up – Time: 9:30–12:00pm. Arrive towards the conclusion of the event in order to help break down all areas of the event, gather all items to be loaded back on truck to be returned to LBRMH, and assist with any clean up of trash and recycling, as well as help remove signage and banners from all areas of the Walk.
