In Honor to Deputy Jake Keltner

We are asking everyone to wear blue on Wednesday the 13th to honor Deputy Jake Keltner. He was a dedicated and hardworking officer whose family is long associated with law enforcement. He had worked for the McHenry County Sheriff's Department for nearly 13 years, becoming a detective in 2009. About five years ago, Keltner volunteered to become a member of the Great Lakes Regional Fugitive Task Force. Thursday he was tragically killed while he and members of a special U.S. Marshals Service task force attempted to arrest a wanted man. He is one of the heroes in blue and his passing is a great loss.
