ISTEP GRADUATION EXAM PART 2 - MANDATORY TEST FOR ALL 10TH GRADERS

The Indiana Department of Education requires all 10th grade students, as a part of the graduation requirements, to take an English and Math exam. The state of Indiana sets the testing windows for these exams, so it is CRITICAL that your 10th grade student is present during testing days.

Please avoid taking your student out of school or scheduling appointments next week Tuesday, April 9th and Wednesday, April 10th, so that they can attempt the required exams.

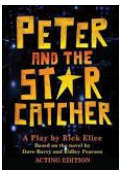
All 10th graders will test morning and afternoon on Tuesday, April 9th and 10th. Students need to bring a charged iPad both days.

Together we will work to make sure your student meets all the graduation requirements necessary. The ISTEP exam is an important part of this process!
