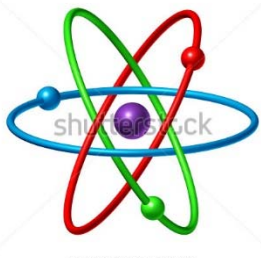

Kathy Wyatt, our office tech will be retiring. Please take the opportunity to

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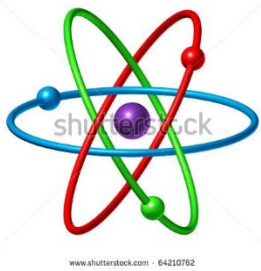
thank her and wish her well. Kathy will be back for a couple of weeks into the new school year.

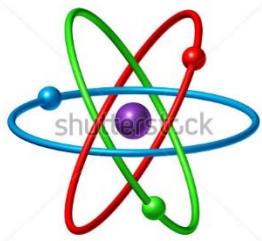

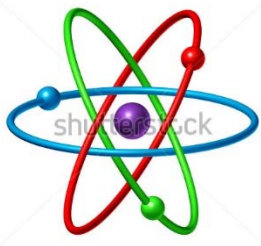

The class that has the best lunch area behavior, will earn 10 extra minutes of recess on Friday. By best behavior I mean:



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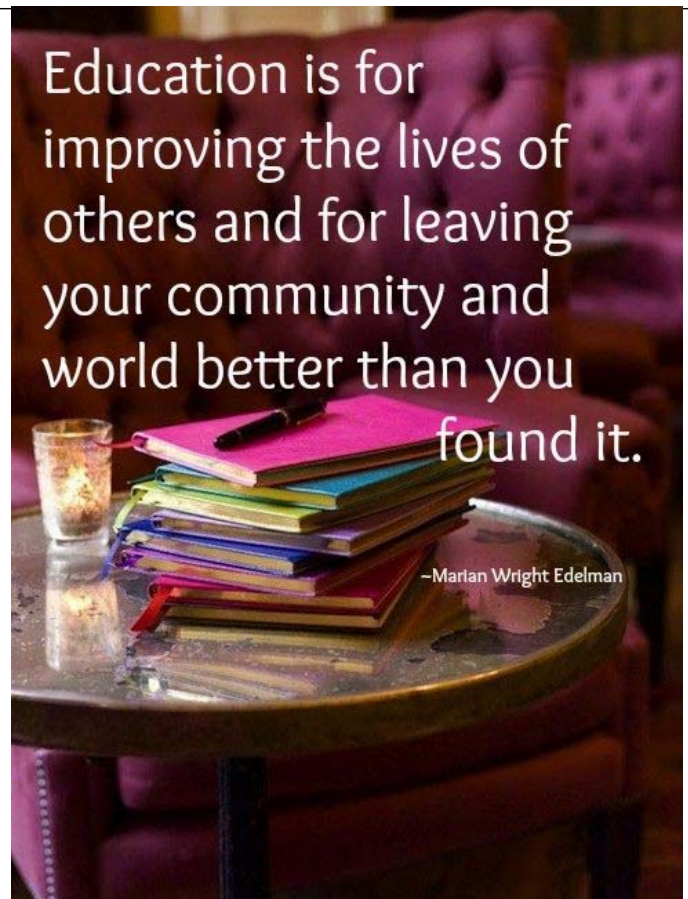
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- Using normal voices during lunch

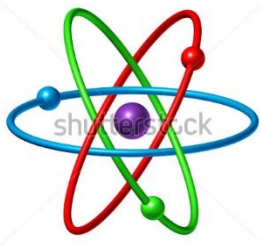

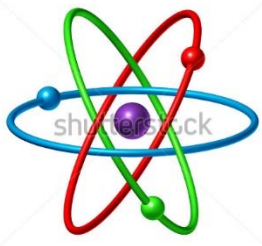

What's PTO?

PTO typically stands for “parent teacher organization” and is the general acronym for the approximately 75 percent of parent-teacher groups that choose to remain independent of the National PTA.

What's the difference between “PTO” and “PTA”?

PTAs are local groups that affiliate with the National PTA. These groups pay dues to their respective state PTAs and to the National PTA, and they receive benefits from those organizations. PTOs on the other hand, are free to write their own bylaws, and they can either charge no dues



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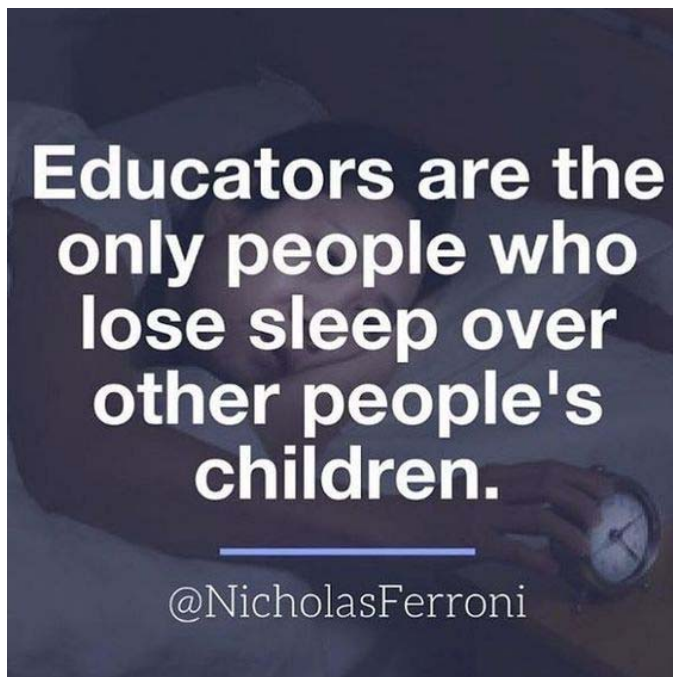
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at all-or keep whatever dues they do charge at their schools.

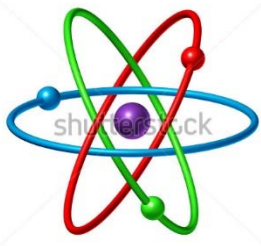

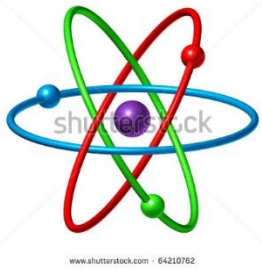
