Please allow me to introduce myself. My name is Maricelly Hernandez and I am the Certified Nurse Assistant Program Coordinator for the Youth Transitions to Work Program.

The Youth Transitions to Work (YTTW) **FREE** College Apprenticeship programs are NJ Department of Labor-funded and designed to train and place young adults into paid apprenticeships at Barnabas Medical Center and other healthcare institutions. We are looking for high school seniors interested in nursing or physical therapy with a minimum GPA of 2.5 and good teacher recommendations. Students must have good reading and math abilities. The program lasts 6 months, from the end of June to the end of December at which time students are placed into employment. **The scholarship totals \$13,500.**

Students admitted to the program enjoy the following:

1. College scholarship which pays for 13.5 general education credits, all credits are transferable to the college of their choice.
2. Free training as either a Certified Nursing Assistant or Physical Therapy Aide
3. Job placement at a local hospital, nursing home or medical facility
4. Free transportation to and from the program for the first three months
5. Free academic enrichment to prepare students for clinical exams
7. Free soft skill training, including resume writing and interview skills
8. And much more!

The YTTW apprenticeship programs have been a NJ DOL-funded training to work program in NJ since 1994 and have been instrumental in placing hundreds of deserving young healthcare workers into para-professional jobs. Many students find it an ideal way to enter healthcare, receive effective professional training and pay for their degrees going forward.
