

Educational Enrichment Trip to San Francisco March 26-30, 2020

Hotel Accommodations:

Staybridge Suites San Francisco Airport 1350 Huntington Avenue, San Bruno, CA.

We have reserved two bedroom suites for our group. The suites consist of one bedroom with a queen bed and a bathroom, one bedroom with two double beds and a bathroom, and one sleeper sofa in the living area. Chaperones will be assigned in each suite. The price of the trip is based on 7 people in a suite.

These are some of the adventures that we are checking out for the trip. It does not mean that we will be able to schedule all of activities.

1. Tour of Alcatraz Island – check out the cell blocks and learn about the escape from Alcatraz.
2. Exploratorium – hands on museum of science, art, and human perception. Scientific American magazine rated the Exploratorium “the best science museum in the world”.
3. Cable Car ride and the Cable Car Museum
4. Wok Wiz Tour with a focus on the folklore and history of Chinatown, lunch is included.
5. Lombard Street – known (erroneously) as the “most crooked” street in the world.
6. Fisherman’s Wharf and Ghirardelli Square
7. Walk across the Golden Gate Bridge
8. Muir Woods National Park – 550 acre home to coastal redwoods, which are some of the largest tree species in the world.
9. Possible side trip and personal tour of “Google” in Mountain View, CA
10. San Francisco Zoo or San Francisco Aquarium

Based on 50-55 participants, **the cost of the trip is tentatively set at \$895.00.** This includes all transportation, hotel accommodations for 3 nights, and activities. The cost of the trip includes most meals but does NOT include all meals. United does not have free baggage if you need to pack more than a carry-on.

Students may sign up on a first come, first serve basis with priority given to students in grades 9-12.

Adults are also encouraged to sign up early but the combination of students going and the type of hotel rooms we have booked, will help determine our need for chaperones.

It is unfortunate but late payments cannot be accepted as the airline must have the exact number of tickets we need by the first week in December.
