NOTICE OF INTENT TO INCREASE NONVOTED LEVIES  
March 14, 2018

The Anaconda School District is committed to financial transparency. Senate Bill 307 (SB307) requires the District to provide notice of its intent to increase nonvoted levies in the ensuing fiscal year. As an essential part of its budgeting process, the Anaconda School District #10 Board of Trustees is authorized by law to impose levies to support its budget. The Anaconda School District #10 Board of Trustees estimates the following increases/decreases in revenues and mills for the funds noted below for the next school fiscal year beginning July 1, 2019, using certified taxable valuations from the current school fiscal year as provided to the District:

Paint Ceiling in Little Theater; Repair sagging, cracking or spalling paint where needed; Potential asbestos abatement; Remodel and or repair all locker rooms at Memorial Gym; Signage directing ADA access; Replace or repair roof, paint, lighting and garage door at track garage and lawn garage; Replace/repair roof over Fred Moodry Gym; Replace boiler pneumatic controls at Fred Moodry; Other projects referenced in the 2008 facilities condition inventory report.

These estimates are the District's best estimates at the current time. They are based on the current year's taxable value, as required by SB307. These estimates are preliminary and changes are expected before the final budgets are set in August 2018.
