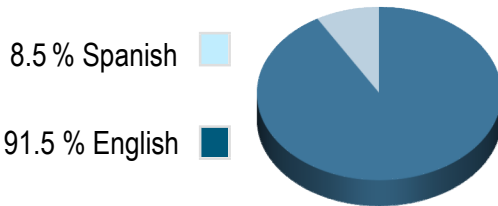

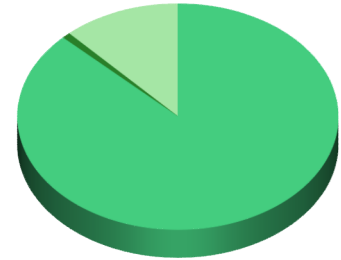

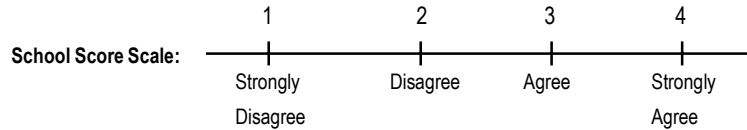


How was the parent perception survey submitted?
