## We Act At We Day

Last Thursday, several students from St. Anthony School attended We Day at Key Arena. These students are part of the WE Act Student Group.

WE Act is a comprehensive, service learning program that nurtures compassion in young people and gives them the tools to create change and take social action in their school and in their community. WE Act gives students the opportunity to participate in student-led campaigns throughout the year to benefit both local and global communities.



This year, the St. Anthony WE Act Group, led by Mrs. Jones and made up of a group of seventh and eighth-grade students:

- Collected and assembled almost 500 WE Care Kits for children and adults.
- Organized the penny drive and collected \$3,051.89 for St. Anne in Haiti to help them add a seventh-grade class and hire teachers.
- Collected over 2,000 toothbrushes that were sent to Haiti in October.
- Collected 3,812 canned food items during the WE Scare Hunger food drive in the fall.

In recognition for their hard work, St. Anthony WE Act students earned tickets to the WE Day celebration where they heard from well-known inspirational speakers, musical acts and learned how they could change the world.

### Online Uniform Exchange closes Friday


The new online platform for uniform exchanges was a success! The platform closes this Friday, so requests can be submitted until May 11th using the link below.
