

NON-TUITION SUMMER SCHOOL
FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

- I APPLIED FOR A CLASS, BUT I DON'T SEE MY NAME ON THE LIST. WHAT HAPPENED? Unfortunately, this happens more often than not. There are always many more registrations than open spaces for students. For example, we may have 160 students request Civics and Economics, but we only have two classes and can't give it to everyone.
- BUT I TURNED IN MY APPLICATION ON THE FIRST DAY. DON'T I GET PRIORITY OVER SOMEONE WHO TURNED IT IN LATER? No, there is no priority for early registration. All students who registered during the registration window have the same chance of getting the class.
- IF I DIDN'T GET THE CLASS I WANTED, DO I HAVE ANOTHER CHANCE? Yes. Any students trying to add a summer school class may go to the MPR on the first day of summer school at 7:45 am. Spots are not guaranteed, but if any students who got the class do not show up on the first day, their seat in the class will be given away by lottery. Don't worry about arriving super early – the lottery is random with everyone there by 7:45 having an equal chance of getting in with no preference for early arrivals.
- IS THERE ANOTHER OPTION? Yes. If you didn't get into a free class, there are tuition courses offered by Dedicated2Learning. Follow the link on our summer school website for more information.
- MY FRIEND GOT THE CLASS I WANT, BUT NOW SHE'S GOING TO DROP IT. CAN I HAVE HER SPOT? No. The seat in class is not hers to will to you. Any open seats will be filled on the first day of summer school by the random lottery held in the MPR.
- I GOT A D OR F IN THE SECOND SEMESTER OF ENGLISH OR HISTORY. CAN I STILL SIGN UP FOR SUMMER SCHOOL? Absolutely. Students making up a D or F in a graduation requirement will get a spot in summer school. Just show up on the first day and go to the theater and we will sign you up. Students with a D or F in a non-graduation requirement like math can try to add, but they are not guaranteed a spot.
- I AM IN A CLASS SPONSORED BY MT. SAC. WHERE ARE THE CLASSES HELD? All of our summer school classes are held on the WHS campus Monday-Thursday, 7:30 am – 1:00 pm.
- I GOT INTO A NON-TUITION CLASS, BUT IT SAID I NEED TO FINALIZE MY REGISTRATION BY GOING TO A MEETING IN THE Library – DO I HAVE TO GO? Yes! If you got into a free class, it's sponsored by Mt. SAC, and they need your signature (not your parent's), so you must go to the Library on the registration completion date. They would also like your Social Security # if possible.
- I AM GOING TO MISS TWO DAYS OF SUMMER SCHOOL. IS THAT OK? No, it's NOT OK. Students can only miss one day in each three-week semester, and even that

much is highly discouraged. Every day of summer school is the equivalent of a week and a half of class, and missing even one day will make it very hard to pass your class.

- WHAT IF I'M GOING TO MISS FOR AN ACADEMIC EVENT OR A SCHOOL-SPONSORED EVENT? DOES THAT ALLOW ME TO MISS TWO OR MORE DAYS? No. Congratulations on your participation in something cool, but the summer school attendance policy has no exemptions. Students can only miss one day per semester.
- IS SUMMER SCHOOL TAKEN FOR CREDIT? WILL THE CLASS/GRADE GO ON THE STUDENT'S PERMANENT RECORD? Yes, the courses offered at WHS are credit only classes. We do not offer "enrichment" courses during the summer session. All classes will go on your student transcript.
