For 30 consecutive years, **FLAG** has been offering **French, Spanish, Mandarin and Japanese** classes to Westfield elementary students (K-5).

FLAG is a non-profit group with roots in the Westfield Parent Teacher Council (PTC), offering after school programs in a long-standing arrangement with the Westfield Public Schools. Our highly qualified teachers introduce the children to the target languages through interactive oral methods, using songs, simple skits, games or art projects. Each class is adapted to the level and knowledge of the students. **FLAG** allows the children to discover an exciting new way of communicating and learning about different cultures.

- **Introduction & Basic knowledge of a foreign language - level I & II**
- **Reinforcement of the elementary school Spanish curriculum**
- **Opportunity to get familiarized with French before 6th grade**
- **Mandarin level I & II**

LEVEL I Level I class is offered to **K-5** with no previous language experience. The vocabulary covers basic colors, food, numbers, animals, members of the family and daily activities. All instruction is based on **oral comprehension** so the student can develop a natural accent in the target language and be encouraged to actively speak in simple, complete sentences. Additional **cultural themes** are included during classes.

LEVEL II Open to students who completed one year in **FLAG** or children who already have a previous knowledge of the language. The program helps them to acquire a better sense of **full phrasing**, an understanding of simple commands and to develop social skills in the language. **Reading** and **writing** in the language is gradually introduced to broaden their vocabulary and deepen their skills. Returning students and more advanced students will be placed together according to their experience with the language.

An **Immersion Day Program** will be offered on a Saturday morning, to provide the students with an opportunity to use their new skills through plays, arts, crafts, music and dance. Registration forms will be sent early January and confirmed according to a sufficient number of students signed up.

GENERAL INFORMATION

Classes are held at **EDISON** and **ROOSEVELT** Schools from **4:00pm to 5:00pm**, once a week. The program will start the week of **October 15^h 2018** and will run until the end of **March 2019**.
Tuition is \$280 for the 20-week session.

- If the form is sent by the due date, take advantage of **\$10 Early Registration Discount** (\$270)
- Registration deadline is **September 30th** and a **\$20 late fee** will be charged **after** that date.
- Registration is on a first-come first-served basis and tuition is non-refundable.
