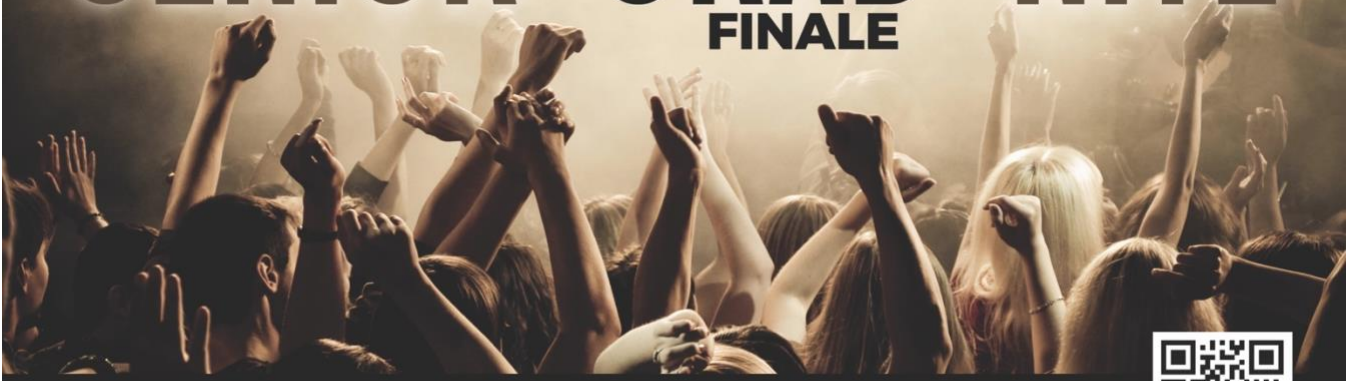

# GRAD NITE POLICIES AND RULES

Our goal is to have a safe and exciting event where all seniors can enjoy their last night together as Peninsula Panthers!

## The BASICS

students may not leave the location during Grad Nite .

Strict NO Alcohol or Drug Policy

Strict NO Violence Policy

Any student who is suspected of being under the influence of drugs or alcohol, is acting violently, or is not following the rules of the evening will have their parents notified to pick them up immediately.

## NO OVER THE COUNTER MEDICATIONS MAY BE BROUGHT

Tylenol, Advil, Lip Balm, and Contact Lens Solution will be available at the venue if needed, at no charge. Feminine hygiene products will be available at the venue, at no charge.

## RESTRICT BRINGING VALUABLES

Better to be safe than sorry. Chaperones will not be responsible to hold or store any valuables

## POLICY ON DRINKING, SMOKING AND DRUGS

We ask that you and your senior respect the spirit of Grad Nite. There will be a ZERO TOLERANCE to alcohol, drugs, any form of tobacco, smoking, or vaping. **THERE WILL BE NO REFUNDS!** To implement these rules, seniors entering the gym will be subject to a light *search by a professional security company.*

**WE WILL ABSOLUTELY NOT ALLOW ANY STUDENT WHO IS UNDER THE INFLUENCE OF ANY DRUG OR ALCOHOL TO BOARD THE BUS.**

## PLEASE FOLLOW THE RULES

To get all our over 400 graduates checked in and off to Grad Nite in a timely manner we are asking all attendees to listen carefully to check in instructions. Food and drinks will be provided in the gym.

Please review and follow the rules attached to the consent form.

## DO WE HAVE YOUR UPDATED INFORMATION?

Please contact us if you have changed your phone numbers since the Consent Form was filled out.

It is imperative that we are able to reach you in case of an emergency.

Please make sure every student includes their cell phone number on the consent form.

# GRAD NITE DETAILS

## WHAT YOU SHOULD KNOW....



The “2019 Grad Nite” experience will start immediately after the Graduation Ceremony.

### SHOULD MY SENIOR GO HOME AFTER GRADUATION TO CHANGE CLOTHES?

**NO!!** Immediately after the Graduation Ceremony the graduates will need to return their cap & gown and then pick-up their diploma. Once that is done the graduate should **change their dressy clothes to casual clothes.** We encourage the graduates to wear comfortable clothing and shoes to Grad Nite (Girls - no high heels). **Parents,** please make sure that your graduate sends his/her dressy clothes home with you. Or they can put their clothes in the “Check Room” inside the gym with other items that will be left behind and picked up the next morning.

### WHAT IF MY SENIOR NEEDS PRESCRIBED MEDICATION DURING THE COURSE OF THE NIGHT?

If your senior needs to take medication that evening, he/she needs to include that on the Consent Form. The medication must be in its original container and placed in a labeled clear Ziploc bag with your child’s name on the bag. The medication will be kept safely in a labeled bag with a designated volunteer at the venue. If possible, administer your student’s medication before he/she checks in for Grad Nite. We will also accept contact lens cases and eye glasses in a clear Ziploc bag with the student’s name on it.

### WHAT IF MY SENIOR WANTS TO LEAVE THE VENUE EARLY?

**This will not be possible,** as the only means of returning will be on the buses that will return once the event is over. No senior will be allowed to leave Grad Nite once they’ve checked-in and boarded a bus. The volunteer staff will only call a parent or guardian if there is a problem. **Yes, even for 18 year old graduates.**

### WHAT WILL MY SENIOR NEED FOR THE GRAD NITE PARTY?

No money is required at Grad Nite. A sweatshirt or jacket is needed because the venue is outside. **A Clear Backpack will be provided to hold your stuff.**

It is advisable **NOT TO BRING ANYTHING OF VALUE.** We will not be held responsible for any lost or stolen items left behind in the “Check Room” or at the venue. The volunteers in the gym “Check Room” will not accept valuable items such as jewelry. Please leave your items with your parents after the ceremony.

Since Cell Phones are allowed this year, Please make sure every student includes their cell phone number on the consent form just in case they need to be reached during the evening.

## GRAD NITE RULES AND GUIDELINES

To help ensure the safety of all attendees, as well as to protect the volunteers, all PVPHS school rules apply, including the dress code and code of conduct. In addition:

- Only current PVPHS graduating seniors are eligible to attend.
- All students, including those 18 years old or older, must have the Consent Form completed and signed by a parent or legal guardian in order to attend this event.
- This event will observe a **ZERO TOLERANCE POLICY**. Light pat downs may be necessary. The use, presence or possession of **any alcoholic beverages and/or illegal drugs, including marijuana** is prohibited. Smoking is not permitted. All tobacco products, e-cigarettes, lighters and matches will be confiscated. If a graduate is in possession of or is under the influence of alcohol or drugs, parents will be notified to pick up their senior at the Grad Nite location. No refund will be given.
- Admission will only be permitted until 8:30 pm Graduation night 2019. Parents will be called if their registered senior fails to check in.
- Should a senior become ill, the parent or guardian will be called and may be required to pick up the senior at the Grad Nite location.
- Student may not bring purses and backpacks; no money is required at Grad Nite. Personal items brought to Grad Nite will be left at school. A check-in room will store all items brought in and be held at the school during the event, however, even items checked in are the responsibility of the senior. Please DO NOT bring valuables. Electronic devices will not be permitted.
- Decorations are not to be removed or damaged.
- Parents will be financially liable for any damages caused by their student.
- Dress is casual. We suggest you bring a sweatshirt for the cool morning hours. Shoes and shirt are required. No pocket chains.
- Student may bring only a sweatshirt / jacket on the bus.
- No bottles, cans or thermoses may be brought to Grad Nite. Students may be subject to a Breathalyzer test. No food may be taken to Grad Nite. All food and refreshments will be provided. Gum is not allowed for the protection of the facility.
- **No refunds will be given after May 1, 2019.**
- Only medications listed on the Grad Nite 2019 Consent Form will be allowed. Any medication not pre-approved will be confiscated.
- Buses will return to PVPHS at approximately 6:30am the following morning. No graduate will be permitted to leave Grad Nite early.
