DISTRICT ENROLLMENT REQUIREMENT

The principals shall verify the ages of students who are enrolling in the district for the first time. A certified state birth certificate is required, plus all students must meet state immunization requirements.

Age Requirements:

- To attend PPCD, children must be three years old and meet state requirements.
- To attend Pre-Kindergarten, children must be four years old on or before September 1st of the current school year and meet state requirements.
- To attend Kindergarten, children must be five years old on or before September 1st of the current school year.
- To attend First Grade, children must be six years old on or before September 1st of the current school year.

BAD WEATHER INFORMATION

In the event bad weather prevents the opening or delay of schools, an announcement will be released from the office of the Superintendent through the automated phone system, School Messenger, in addition to the following: KIKZ/KSEM Radio Station 1250 AM and 106.3 FM (Seminole); or Television Channel 2 KMID (Midland); Television Channel 28 KAMC (Lubbock).
