



## **MGAC Pool Guidelines**

1. Swimmers must sign-in at the MGAC Office upon arrival. Print legibly the first name and last name for each person looking to use MGAC facilities. Adults be prepared to show proof of identify upon request (i.e. Driver's License or other Picture ID).
2. , Membership must be verified, or payment made, in pool office prior to any further occupancy or usage of MGAC facilities
3. Swimmers must be compliant with MGAC's EAP and PCHS's safety rules and regulations.
4. MGAC is not responsible for personal belongings and will not hold valuable personal property in office.
5. All participants may park in the Upper Stadium Parking lot or on Temescal Canyon Rd. and must enter MGAC via the main gate on Temescal.
6. Do not walk across campus while school is in session. Permits and Public/Community users of MGAC are not allowed on campus during school hours if their reason for being at PCHS is exclusive to MGAC access/use
7. Any issues or concerns should be reported in a timely manner to a Senior Lifeguard or MGAC Director, Brooke King: [bking@palihigh.org](mailto:bking@palihigh.org).
8. All swimmers must adhere to MGAC personnel's directives and interpretation of pool rules. Pool rules can found at: [Rules and Safety](#)
9. All noise must be controlled to a minimum.
10. No photography (unless approved by Aquatic Director).
11. Swimmers may not enter the facility until all PE class/students have fully exited the facility.
12. No one swimmer is permitted to encumber an open lap lane.
13. No unauthorized lane usage. Lifeguards will assign lanes and reserve the right to adjust open lap lanes due to permitting or to maintain safe circle swimming rotation.
14. Swimmers may not swim prior to or after their scheduled time.
15. Open swim prohibited in permit space..
16. Lockers are shared and intended for same day use only. No overnight use. Overnight use is subject to locks being cut off and discarded and locker contents put in PCHS Lost & Found
17. Please inform the Aquatic Director/Lifeguards of any special needs. We will provide reasonable accommodation to ensure equal access.
