This October 26th, 4-H and Google will launch an exciting NYSD challenge, Code Your World, inviting kids to get involved in computer science (CS) through hands-on doing.

Code Your World is a multi-part challenge that teaches kids grades 4th-8th to apply CS to the world around them through hands-on activities. Developed by Google and West Virginia University Extension Service, it includes a computer-based activity on Google's CS First platform and three unplugged activities that bring coding to life through games and interaction.
