




- Enrollment forms can be found online: www.rbusd.org, Parents/Students tab, click on Enroll in RBUSD
- Enrollment begins in March <u>it is not</u> 1st come, 1st served
- If you need CDC child care, you must have all of your kindergarten information submitted to your home school. Then, you can get a signed form from your home school, which you must submit to the CDC Office in March


Enrollment and Next Steps

- School-of-Choice window is March 1st 29th. If you desire School-of-Choice, notification and needed lotteries will occur in May. You may only choose one program or school for School-of-Choice. Due to limited space in CDC, School-of-Choice students are rarely accepted into the Kinder CDC program (some exceptions for Dual Language and Transitional Kindergarten programs)
- Requests to attend RBUSD for non-residents will be accepted from March 1st to May 31st. Lotteries will be held in mid-June. Priorities are given to students whose parent/s work for RBUSD and then to students with siblings already attending our schools. *Very, very limited spaces tend to be available.*


