2018-19 STEM ACADEMY GOAL UPDATE

Goal #1: STEM Academy students will achieve academic success by earning at least a 3.00 GPA during the 2018-19 school year.

- ◆ Semester 1 progress toward goal: 15% earned a 4.0, 61% earned a 3.5 or higher, and **80% of students earned a 3.0 GPA** or higher during the 1st semester of the 2018-19 school year.

Goal #2: STEM Academy students and parents will demonstrate a commitment to attendance and each student will strive to achieve a 95% attendance rate during the 2018-19 school year.

- ◆ Semester 1 progress toward goal: **70% of students** have an attendance rate that is 95% or higher during the 1st semester of the 2018-19 school year.
