Campus safety is always one of our highest priorities. In the past year, we have implemented several procedures to enhance that safety. Currently we allow for only one ingress/egress through our main gate adjacent to the south parking lot during the instructional day. Through the course of several conversations with parents and the community, the idea of keeping that gate locked and people needing to be “buzzed in” was considered. This would allow for only people who had business at the school to be on campus.

Many of you may have noticed a buzzer, or “doorbell” that is now attached to the gate. We have been working hard to get this technology functioning, and can now keep this gate locked and “buzz” people in and out via a connection with the school office. This will greatly enhance our ability to regulate who is on our campus.

Beginning Monday, February 25, if you wish to enter campus after the instructional day has begun, simply use the doorbell to communicate with the office, and we will unlock the gate, allowing you to enter. Thank you for your understanding and support as we enhance the safety of our campus.
