REGISTRATION –

Select desired activities and note the session, day and times carefully. Complete the attached registration form by Tuesday, January 16. Two payment options are available; you may submit payment with registration form, or sign to approve charges to your account. A confirmation of your child's enrollment status (accepted or cancelled) will be returned to you via weekly folder.

An activity may be cancelled if minimum enrollment is not met.

ROUTINE –

On the designated activity day, a snack will be provided after school and then your child will be escorted from class to his/her activity. If your child is enrolled in our After-School Program, he/she will be returned to that program after the activity is finished. If your child is not enrolled in After School, you must pick him/her up from the activity sponsor, promptly, at the end of class.

**Children who are not picked up at the end of their activity will be taken to the After School Program and may stay until 6 p.m.*

A drop-in fee of \$7 per half hour will be charged.

POLICIES –

If your child is enrolled in After School, there is no discount for the hour that your child participates in an activity. If your child is enrolled in an activity but is absent, there is no refund. If the teacher is absent on the day of the activity or school is unexpectedly closed due to unforeseen circumstances, the class will be rescheduled by the teacher. Registration fees are non-refundable unless the club enrollment does not reach its minimum number stated. A full refund will be made if the activity is cancelled.
