Session #1-Course Descriptions (2/25/19 – 4/12/19)

Basketball **Outdoor Courts** **\$125** **T,TH (3:15-4:30)**

Get ready to hoop it up! Get together with other boys and girls and play basketball in a fun setting! Everyone that signs up will be placed on a team that will play against other teams from Hale in an after school league. Sign up now and improve your chances of making Hale's Varsity or JV teams next year.

World Art and Techniques **C-106** **\$140** **T,TH (3:15-4:30)**

It's time to get creative! Sign up and start spending your afternoons working with different artistic mediums including pencils, paint, pastels and clay while being inspired by artists from around the world. We will be learning about the elements and principles of art while focusing on a dynamic new project each week. (Includes a \$15 supplies fee).

French Language and Culture **F-235** **\$140** **M,W (3:15-4:30)**

Come on a voyage around the world as we explore the different countries and cultures in which French is the official language. Did you know French is spoken in nearly 60 countries and is the official language of almost 30? Did you know that French is the language of diplomacy and it is the official language of the United Nations? You'll learn some basic conversational French as well as some intriguing tidbits about different places around the globe. We'll also sample food! (Includes a \$15 supplies fee).

Intro to Animal Care **Agriculture Center** **\$125** **M,W (3:15-4:30)**

"Agriculture Therapy" -Come and spend time walking, brushing, exercising the goats, learn to feed the animals, handle the hens, collect eggs, and much more! Enrollees can hand feed our tortoise, prepare him for the evening, and plant and grow edible organic food from seed.

Innovative Mind **H-152** **\$130** **M,W (3:15-4:30)**

Could you build a tower that supports weight if the only materials you had were spaghetti and marshmallows? Can you design a vehicle that can change its appearance and blend into the environment? These are a few of the problems we will tackle each week in Odyssey Experience. This course is about hands-on, project-based, collaborative and creative problem solving. Students will be challenged to think creatively and to collaborate with peers to solve problems. All activities are based on Odyssey of the Mind – an international competition that focuses on solving problems creatively. (Includes a \$5 supplies fee).

Introductory Spanish **F-236** **\$125** **M,W (3:15-4:30)**

This Spanish language course is aimed at students who would like to learn conversational Spanish starting with Spanish basics. The course introduces everyday language and includes activities to practice all four language skills: reading comprehension, writing, listening comprehension and speaking. We will prepare you to introduce yourself, ask basic questions, and conduct a brief conversation in Spanish. We will use reference materials, cultural notes, grammar explanations, and functions of language.

Intro to Piano/Keyboard **M-172** **\$125** **Tue-Thu (3:15-4:30)**

Want to learn how to play the keyboard? Mrs. Karagianis is offering a new and exciting keyboard class after school on Tuesdays and Thursdays from 3:15-4:15. No previous music skills are required. Students will learn to read, write, compose, and play music on the keyboard through popular and standard pieces. Come join us in M172!

World Sewing & Embroidery **F-135** **\$125** **T,Th (3:15-4:30)**

Like patterns? Is your eye drawn to color? To the designs you see on fabrics (like clothes & home design such as bed linens, curtains, upholstery)? Do you like the feel of fibers such as soft blankets and flannel sheets? Then come explore the fiber arts with us! We will design fabrics and learn the art of creating fabric including printing, blocking, applique and embroidery. We'll explore various cultures' fiber arts including African Adinkra and Kente designs and Mayan colorful and vibrant woven textiles. Come enjoy the wonder of culture and design.
