Requirements:

1. Must meet GHSA eligibility requirements. Pass 5 of 6 classes previous semester and be on track for graduation.
2. Discipline record review and approval of grade level administrator.
3. Non-refundable \$40 entry fee and application due November 12.
4. \$100 minimum Patron/Sponsorship contributions due January 7.
5. MUST attend ALL practices and rehearsals as well as the interview tea and informational meeting.
6. Informational meeting will be held on November 12. Details to follow.

Rules and Regulations:

1. Judges' decisions are final! Talking with the judges while they are judging is prohibited. If any family, friends of the contestant, or the contestants themselves are caught violating this rule, the contestant will be disqualified.
2. Good sportsmanship is required at all times. Failure to show good sportsmanship (including the parents and guests) will result in the disqualification of the contestant(s) associated. Fees or monies collected will not be refunded and any and all awards will be forfeited. It may also result in the contestant not being allowed to compete in the pageant the following year. This includes the timeframe after the pageant.
3. The Miss Brookwood Scholarship Pageant, the Brookwood High School PTSA, and the host building are not responsible for loss due to injury incurred at pageant events or in travel to and from the pageant. We are also not responsible for any thefts that may occur.
6. The Miss Brookwood Scholarship Pageant requires high moral standards; therefore, any contestant or winner caught engaged in such acts as drinking / drugs, smoking, swearing, etc. on or off of school property, which includes any internet networking sites, will be immediately disqualified at the discretion of the PTSA Pageant Committee and the Officers of the PTSA.
7. Raising financial support beyond the registration/entry fees is strictly optional. At no time will the judges know the amount of funds raised by any contestant until it is announced on stage during the awards ceremony.

Acknowledgment of Requirements, Rules and Regulations

As the parents/legal guardian of the participant named below, or as the participant, I do hereby agree to abide by the rules and regulations as set forth by the Miss Brookwood Scholarship Pageant. I understand the stated participation requirements.
