General

The Board of Education recognizes that in order for teaching and learning to occur there must be an orderly, safe, and nonthreatening educational environment. To that end, school officials, by law and via board policy and regulations, are granted the authority and are expected to create and/or maintain such an environment giving strong consideration to responsible student behavior as an essential developmental component of the learning process. Furthermore, school officials are granted the authority and are expected to take into consideration out-of-school conduct of students who are engaged in non-school-related activities when such conduct poses a threat to the health, safety, and/or welfare of other students and staff as well as the integrity of school programs.
