- **Secondary After-school Care**
For those parents/guardians that have signed up their 7-12 grade children to participate in after-school care, we have begun this daily service this month. The purpose of this program is to allow students time after school to work on homework or receive tutoring for any of their classes. Mrs. DeAngelo and Mrs. Bennett will alternate its supervision. It will run on every school day for the students, unless announced otherwise. The time runs from the end of the school day to 5:30pm, sharp. The cost is \$12 per child, per day, regardless of how long they stay on any day. Families will be billed monthly and separately from other fees. If you did not sign up your child(ren) before school started, you may still do so by filling out and returning the form attached to this email. Forms are also available in the school office. Sign-ups are required before utilizing the program.
