(Advancement Via Individual Determination)

Avid Elementary is a foundational component for elementary schools and is designed to increase the number of students who enroll and succeed in higher education and in their lives beyond high school. AVID strategies are being used TK-grade five here at Hugo Reid. AVID is used at three of the district elementary schools (Longley Way, Holly Avenue, and Hugo Reid).

AVID Elementary incorporates:

Student Success Skills- encompassing communication skills (e.g. listening, speaking and writing), self-advocacy skills, and study skills.

Organizational Skills- both mental and physical; students are given organizational tools, as well as time management, goal-setting, and note-taking strategies.

WICOR Lesson- emphasize instruction on writing to learn, inquiry, collaboration, organization and reading to learn in all content areas.

Partnerships- among students, classrooms, grade levels, sschools, feeder patterns, families and communities.
