Directions

From IH35 take exit 230
Merge onto US-290 W/TX-71 W toward Johnson City
Go 4.1 miles and exit toward TX-1 Loop/Brodie Lane/Southwest Parkway
Move to the right lane and go slight right to Southwest Parkway
Stay on Southwest Parkway 2 miles and turn right on Foster Ranch Road (traffic signal)
Go 0.6 miles and Regents School of Austin will be on your right

Locker Room

Your team will be in a Portable Locker Room which is located across the street west of the football field. Regents will lock the doors when the team is away from the locker room. A police officer or member of our facilities staff will be available to safely assist your team crossing the street for warm-ups, game, halftime and post-game. The locker room is 1,488 sq. ft. and equipped with a shower facility, toilets, and sinks.

Parking

- Bus – The player bus can drop the team off next to their locker room on the street. A Game Administrator will meet the bus and escort the team to their locker room. The Game Administrator will then instruct the bus driver where to park.
- Fans – Spectator parking is available in the lot behind the portable locker room or in main parking lot. Regents personnel and the Police Officers will assist in traffic control and parking.

Team Bench and Warm-up Location

Your team bench will be on the north side of the field underneath the press box. Your team will warm-up on the west side of the field which is opposite the gymnasium, closest to the road.

Coaches and Videographer in the Press Box

Your team will have three spots reserved on the east side of the press box which will be for two coaches and one videographer. If a videographer is not used, an additional coach may *not* take the assigned spot.

Admissions

- \$6 for adults
- \$4 for ages 6 to 18
- Under age 6 is free

Visitor/Cheerleader/Drill Team/Band Seating

Visitor stands are on the north side of the field next to the press box. There is very limited space on the sides of the football field so seating for large drill teams and bands is minimal. There is no seating beyond the end zones.

Halftime Programs

Regents has a halftime program planned and will allow time for your school to also perform if requested. A halftime program request form is attached as a separate document. Please complete and return the form to Bethany Kelm at bkelm@regentsaustin.org by Wednesday the week of the game. Bethany will return the approved form or contact you with any questions by Thursday of game week.

Spectator Restroom Facilities

Restroom facilities are located in the main building to the left of the gym and football field and at the end of the gym corridor. There will be signs directing spectators to the restrooms. Any special needs access to restrooms should be communicated to the Head Game Administrator or Assistant Game Administrators.

Emergency Procedures

- If lightning is present within 8 miles using a lightning detection meter, all parties will be moved to their vehicles or indoors. The event will only be resumed if 30 minutes have passed since the last evidence of lightning.
- Game officials are responsible for declaring a weather delay or cancellation.
- The game announcer will announce any emergency situations with instructions on where to relocate.

Security

Regents will employ at least two uniformed officers to be on site before, during and after the game for traffic control and security.

Concessions

Regents will have a concession stand open with hamburgers, hot dogs, candy, snacks and drinks.

TAPPS General Restrictions

- No live animal mascots, cannons, firearms, fireworks, etc.
- No dogs or other animals
- No sound systems other than the official announcer's system
- No body paint or like decoration by players or spectators (small markings as sold by school organizations are permitted on the cheek)
- No streamers, confetti or other like materials
- No air horns or bull horns, handheld or otherwise
- No use of, or the appearance of using any controlled substance (alcohol, drugs, etc.) before, during or after games

TAPPS Guidelines for Football Performances

Portions of the TAPPS Guidelines for Football Performances are below. Please forward these guidelines to the band director.

3. Band instruments, including drums, are not to be played at any time other than when the entire band is playing.
4. During the contest, bands are to play only
 - a. during pregame,
 - b. halftime,
 - c. postgame,
 - d. the time between quarters,
 - e. time-outs (except injury time-outs) and
 - f. between plays (stopping prior to the referee's whistle for "ready for play").

Tailgating Restrictions

Spectators may tailgate with pre-packaged food and non-alcoholic drinks. Food and drinks may not be brought into the fenced football field area. Food, drink and snacks will be available at the concession stand.
