NOTIFICATION - 763.93 (e)(10) AND (g)(4).

The regulations require that workers, building occupants, or their legal guardians are to be made aware of inspections, re-inspections, response actions, and completed response action activities, including periodic surveillance activities. This notification is required even if the building is eligible for exclusion.

Each year, notification must be given to anyone associated with the school. This annual notification will also include information about the availability of the management plan. **A dated copy of this notification must be included in the Management Plan each year.**

4. Staff meetings, public address announcements (about where to find the written notification), parent organization meetings, and/or school newsletters/handbook.
5. Verbal announcement and distribution of notice at Staff/Parent/Student meetings.
6. Posting on School's web site
7. Other appropriate method(s) of notification.
