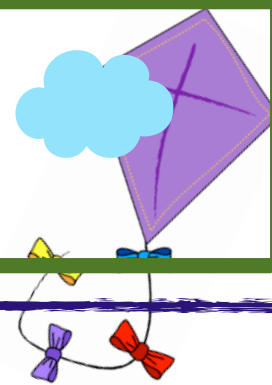




March News
