## BookFlix

This resource pairs fiction story books to related nonfiction topics. You can watch, read, do puzzles, meet the author and explore the web as you learn from the stories and their related topics. The topics included are: Animals & Nature, Earth & Sky, People & Places, ABC's & 1,2,3's, Family & Community, Music & Rhyme, Adventure, Celebrations, and Imagination.

## CyberSmarts

This is an interactive eBook collection for grades 3-6 that helps students learn about online safety issues that include: Avoiding online predators, playing games online, protecting privacy, stopping cyberbullying, and using social networks.

## KidsSearch

This resource is designed for grades K-8 and allows searching of a wide range of magazine and newspaper articles that are professionally selected and grade level appropriate.

## Searchasaurus

This resource allows primary school students to search 80 popular full text magazines, the Funk and Wagnalls Encyclopedia, the American Heritage Dictionary, and the Encyclopedia of Animals.

## Sirs Discoverer

This resource is a general reference database for elementary and middle school students that searches 2,000 newspapers, magazines, and other reference materials.

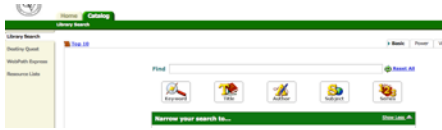
The Edgeworth Library Home Page will appear with links to all of the library's resources.

You will also see a second tab titled Catalog. Searching the Web Catalog can be done by clicking on this Catalog tab.



## The Edgeworth Web Catalog

Follow the directions listed on the front page of brochure. The web catalog lists all the books in the library collection including all eBook holdings. You can search for books available in the library by entering a title, an author, a subject, a series or a keyword. Once you have entered one of these, simply press the option that fits your search term. Keyword is the most often used search tool.



## WebPath Express

WebPath Express is a part of the web catalog. It allows the user to link to relevant up-to-date approved Internet sites directly from the online catalog. If you search for a book then click on the details for that record,



you will see the WebPath link under the Explore heading.



If you cannot find a book on your subject, but still would like to be linked to a website, you can search the WebPath Express website by clicking on the link that is located to the left of the search box on the catalog page.



## Grolier Online

Grolier Online offers the **Amazing World of Animals** which features information on animals and is leveled for elementary, middle, high school, and adult users.

## World Book Online

World Book Online is an interactive online encyclopedia that offers exciting information on people, places, and things from all over the globe. The different options are leveled to make it an excellent resources for all learners.

**World Book Kids** is an interactive general reference encyclopedia for students grades K-4.

**World Book Student** is an online reference encyclopedia for students in grades 5-9 featuring over 45,000 articles, including information from yearbooks dating back to 1922.

**World Book Advanced** is an online reference tool for students in grades 9-12 and extending to the college level. It offers many research options other than the secondary source articles including World Newspapers and In the News. It also features several thousand primary sources and 4,000 eBooks including both fiction and nonfiction. eBooks includes both the works of Shakespeare and Dickens.
