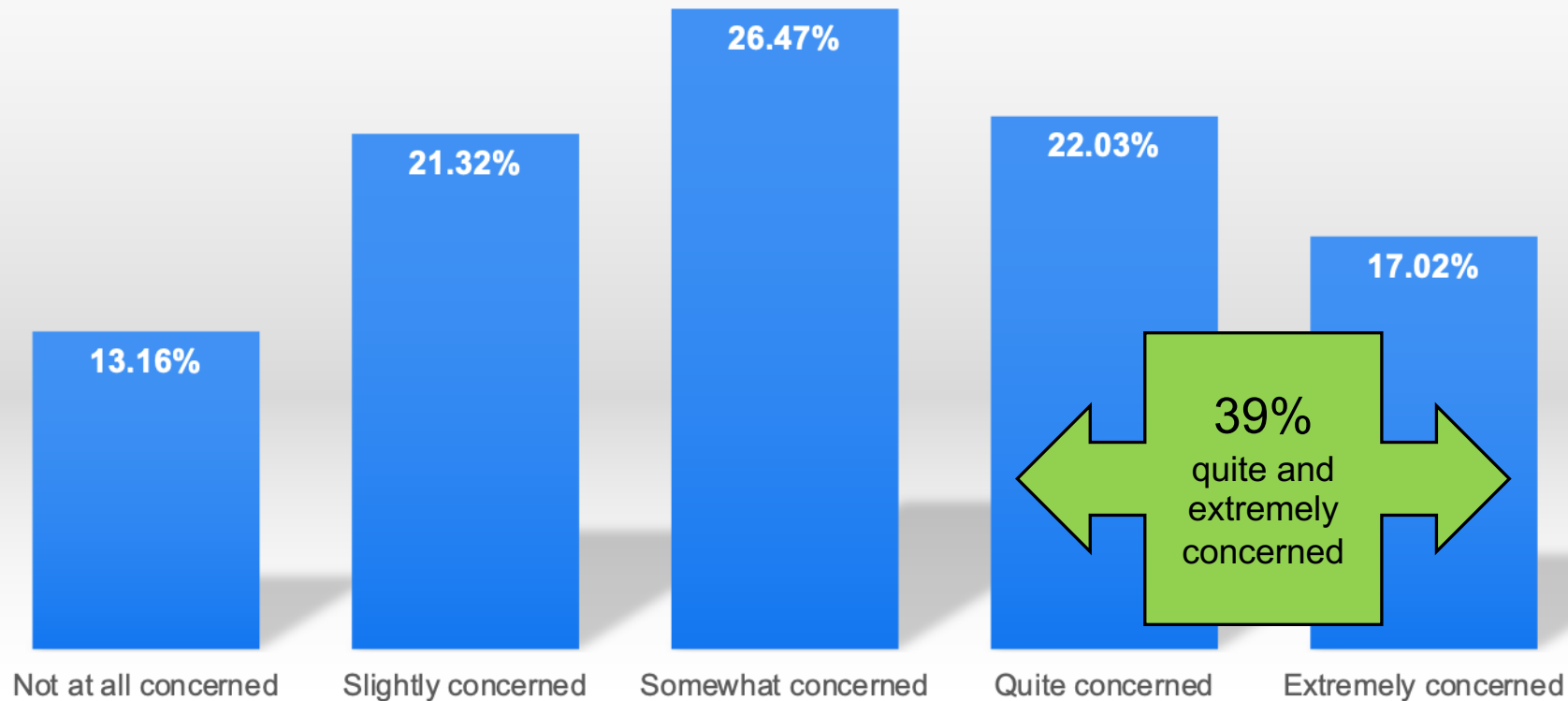

■ Responses

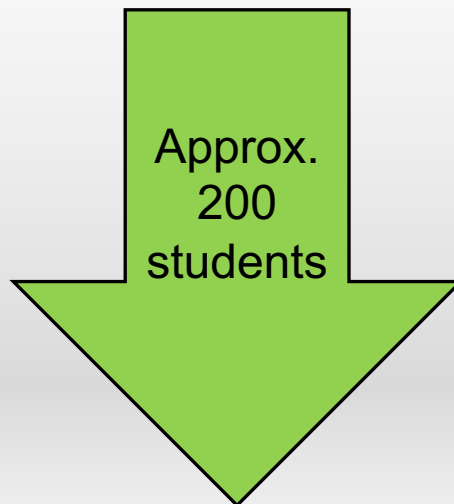

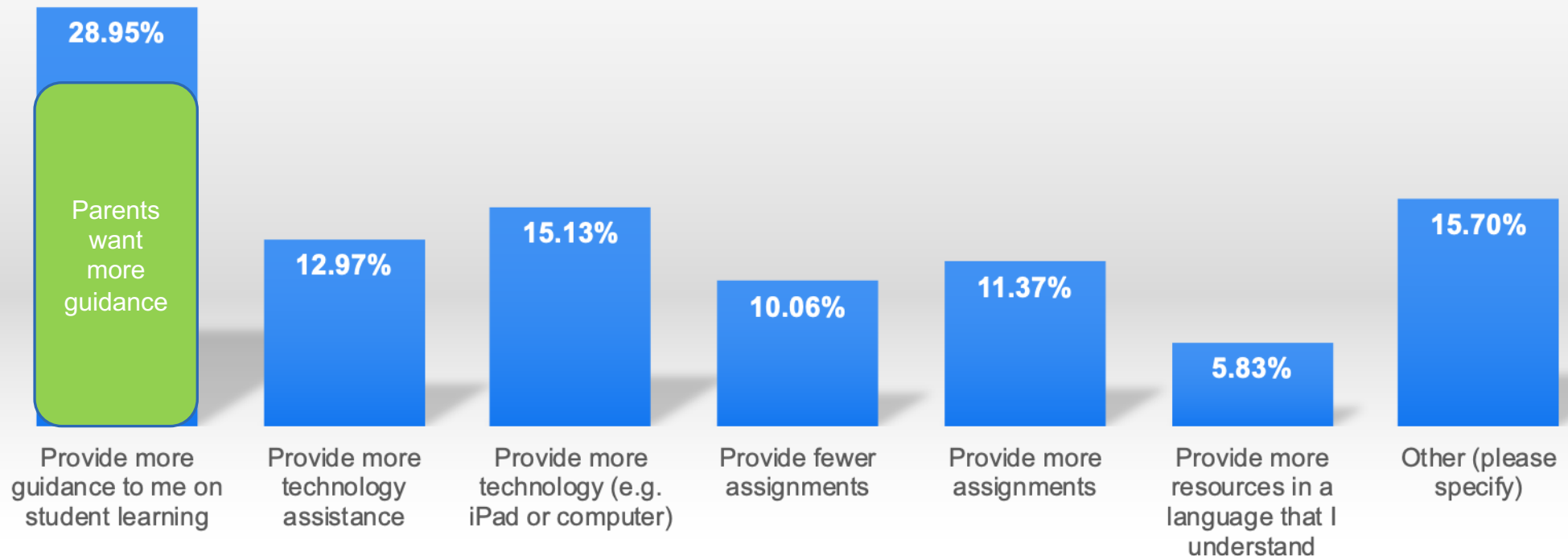
My child has reliable access to high-speed internet.

■ Responses





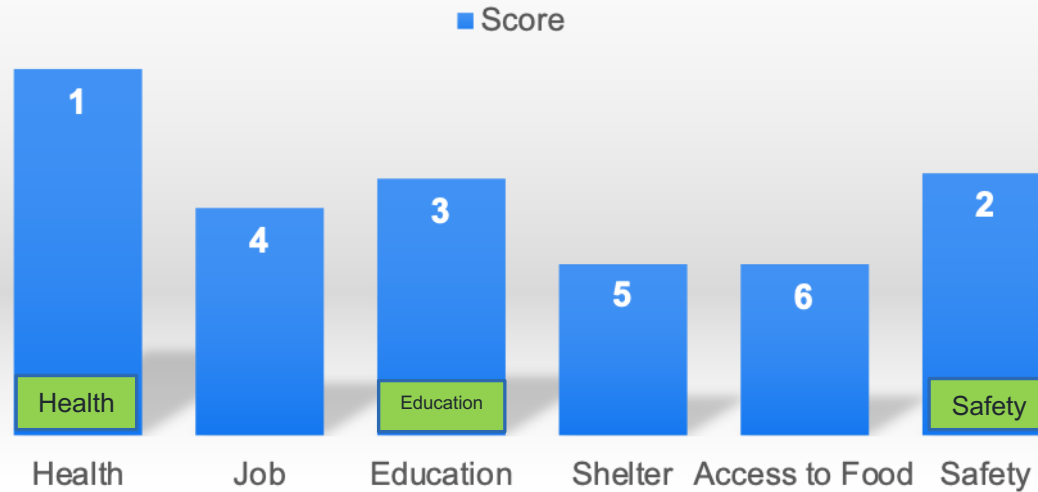
Parent Survey Summary Results

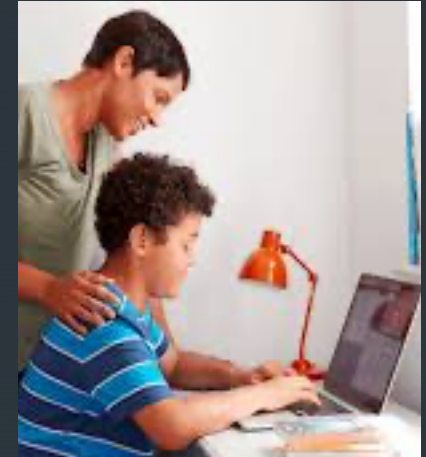

K-8 Academy for Accelerated Learning (AAL) Fall Registration

- Parents / guardians interested in their student(s) attending AAL for the 2020-21 school year will begin registration in late July - early August.
- This is 100% online program for students in grades K-8.
- To ensure continuity of program, parents/families will need to commit to:
 - a **minimum of** one trimester (elementary) or one quarter (middle) or;
 - a **maximum of** an entire school year
- Parents/guardians will be required to get a referral from their home school, sign-up for a mandatory orientation and attend a virtual information meeting in order to receive the registration information
